# Complains Trains Block Crossing

The effect of the truckers' strike in Ontario is being felt in Campbellville. At the regular meeting of Nassagaweya Township council on Monday evening, Deputy-Reeve William Hoey told council, "School buses have been delayed at Campbellville crossing for as long as 20 minutes, because trains are stopped across the crossing."

Deputy-Reeve Hoey said he had been informed the delay of trains in front of the crossing was caused by the truckers' strike. It was explained that because of the strike the trains are much longer than usual.

It was suggested that if it happens again, the bus driver should take the serial numbers of the cars involved and phone the train dispatcher and inform him

Councillors also:

- Accepted the resignation of Councilor R. R. McCallaway.
- Received a statistics chart from Halton County Crown Attorney P. K. McWilliams pointing out the startling increase in fatalities caused by automobile accidents in the county. The report indicated 40 deaths resulted in 1965 because of automobile accidents, while 22 occurred in 1964.

- Approved the application of Roy Wood for a wrecking yard licence.
- Deferred a request from Milton Quarries for the renewal of their quarry licence. Councillor Mrs. Anne MacArthur stated, "I think the charge of \$2 for a quarry licence is ridiculous. It costs

more than that to look after the licence."

- Agreed to discuss quarry licences at a meeting to be held later this week. Council's report concerning the needs study for Halton and Peel Counties will also be discussed at the meeting.

- Approved road accounts totalling \$4,556.68.

- Approved the Township Planning Board's recommendation to have Maurice Newton and Alex Near appointed as the Township's representatives on Halton County Planning Association.

- Approved general accounts totalling \$1,845.49.
- Received membership in the Association of Ontario Mayors and Reeves and also in the Ontario Municipal Association.
- Approved land separations

- Referred applications for the position of Roads Department to the Roads Committee and the road superintendent.

- Agreed to allow the Tuberculosis Association of Canada to use the Township Hall on March 10 and 15 between the hours of 2 p.m. and 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. and 10 p.m. when Tuberculosis "patch tests" will be given.

## Fame Makes Another Try Plan Meeting in Halton

Eight Halton FAME shareholders were among 520 attending a do-or-die meeting of Farmers Allied Meat Enterprises at Stratford last week when the farmer-owners dug into their pockets once again and came up with close to \$60,000 toward saving the co-operative.

Directors called the meeting to see if there was any point in attempting to revive the organization after it lost a \$1,500,000 down payment in its attempt to purchase the F. W. Freeman meat packing plant in Burlington for failure to produce a \$1,000,000 second payment on time.

The failure resulted in a government inquiry in which directors were blamed for poor management in their earlier dealings.

FAME president William Anderson said shareholders would have to raise \$1,000,000 in share capital. Shares are being sold at \$100 each in minimum lots of two shares. Special meetings with county groups will be held in the near future but Halton FAME chairman Roy Break hasn't received a date for a county meeting to date.

"No one spoke of anything but going ahead with it," Halton secretary Stan May reported following the meeting. He pointed out money used to buy shares now will be held in trust until May 31 at which time if there is insufficient money to go ahead, the money will be returned to shareholders less a five per cent handling charge.
