#### Woman, daughter hurt in accident

A Speyside woman and her 14-year-old daughter were hospitalized Thursday afternoon after a car went out of control and slammed head-on into a tree on Highway 25 north of Five Mile Lake.

Mrs. Sadie Kelly of R.R. 1, Milton, is still in Milton District Hospital with head lacerations and bruises to her knees, elbow and ankle as a result of the car accident. Her daughter Doris Anne Kelly had a fractured jaw, ribs and fingers.

Police said the car, owned by Mrs. Kelly's son, Dennis, was being driven north on Highway 25 when it slid out of control about 420 feet east of the side road. It was raining heavily at the time. The car, a 1965 Dodge was classed as a total wreck. Mrs. Kelly and her husband Henry operate the Speyside General Store on Highway 25 at Five Mile Lake.

#### 12 at Twin Lakes lose investments

Twin Lakes Development, a recreational development on the St. Helena Road south of Speyside in Esquewaug Township, which was started in 1961, brought 12 investors, no returns on \$68,000 they invested, an Ontario Securities Commission investigator was reported as saying in court.

Developers of the bankrupt firm are charged with a breach of the securities act. The trial resumes later this month. The 240-acre recreational project fell through not long after it started and has since been turned into a flying club headquarters.
