## Three Acton students at Waterloo seminar

High school students from across Canada took part in the annual United Nations Seminar from Sunday, June 19 to Saturday, June 25.

The University of Waterloo played host to 142 students attending a week long Ontario Regional Seminar. This is the fourth such seminar to be held at the University since 1962. Acton sends representatives each year.

The seminar is designed to give the participating students an insight into the working of the United Nations by active debate on some of the actual problems delegates at the United Nations encounter.

The general theme of this year's seminar is "The Price of Peace". Topics for debate and resolutions are: The Vietnam War, The Control of Nuclear Arms, The Rhodesia Problem, and World Population and Food Problems.

Each student acts as a delegate for one of the 54 nations represented in this UN assembly. Study kits are provided before the seminar in order to familiarize the delegates with UN procedures and the philosophy of the country they will represent. They are encouraged to keep in mind that they are a diplomat representing Russia, Canada, the U.S., Britain, or whatever; not a student.

In the words of Michael Primiani, Montreal exchange delegate to the 1965 seminar held at the University of Waterloo: "A UN seminar may be characterized as 'G.R.I.A.T.' which embodies: Gratifying, Rewarding, Entertaining, Educational, Absorbing, and Thought-provoking."

Students attending the seminar are sponsored by their high school student councils or local service organizations.

Students attending from Acton high school were Brenda McCowan, 170 Churchill Road, who was sponsored by Lakeside Chapter of the I.O.D.E.; Neil Anderson, 20 Knox Ave., who was sponsored by Acton Rotary Club, and Gary Dobbie, R.R. 2, who was sponsored by the Duke of Devonshire chapter of the I.O.D.E.

All three represented India. It's expected they'll write a report of the seminar for the Free Press.
