**Bruce McClure's farm wins improvement prize**  
 Bruce McClure, Georgetown, is the winner of Halton's Centennial Farmstead Improvement Contest, sponsored by the Ontario Department of Agriculture and the Halton Federation of Agriculture. His farm will be judged on a Provincial level with the winners of other Ontario Counties. The Provincial prizes are as follows: first prize \$500, second prize \$400, third prize \$300, fourth prize \$200, fifth prize \$100, sixth prize \$75, seventh prize \$50 and eighth prize \$25.  
 The competition was first conceived by the Department of Agriculture and Horticultural Societies Branch of the Ontario Department of Agriculture, as a centennial project to beautify the Ontario countryside for centennial year.  
 The Halton County Department of Agriculture took up the project and contacted the Halton County officials who decided to have a centennial tree planting project for the County. The Department of Agriculture also contacted the Halton Federation of Agriculture who started the Halton County Centennial Farmstead Improvement Contest.  
 The farms were visited in August 1965 and inspected and scored. They were visited in August 1966 and scored again. The prizes were awarded according to the gain made from August 1965 to August 1966. There were 25 farms in the competition. The Halton Federation of Agriculture matched the prize money offered by the Ontario Department of Agriculture by adding \$150. All contestants will receive at least \$75.
