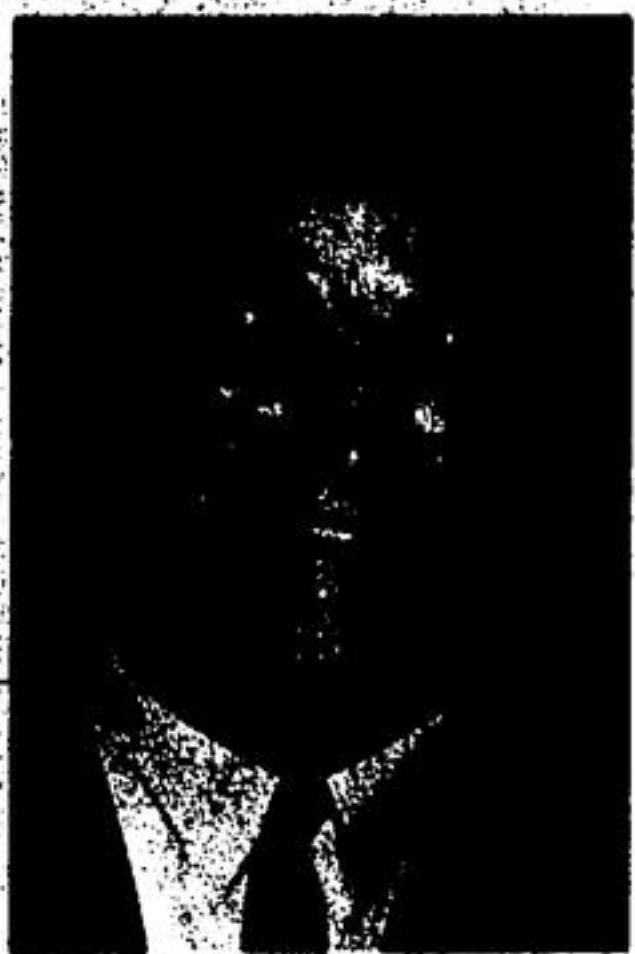
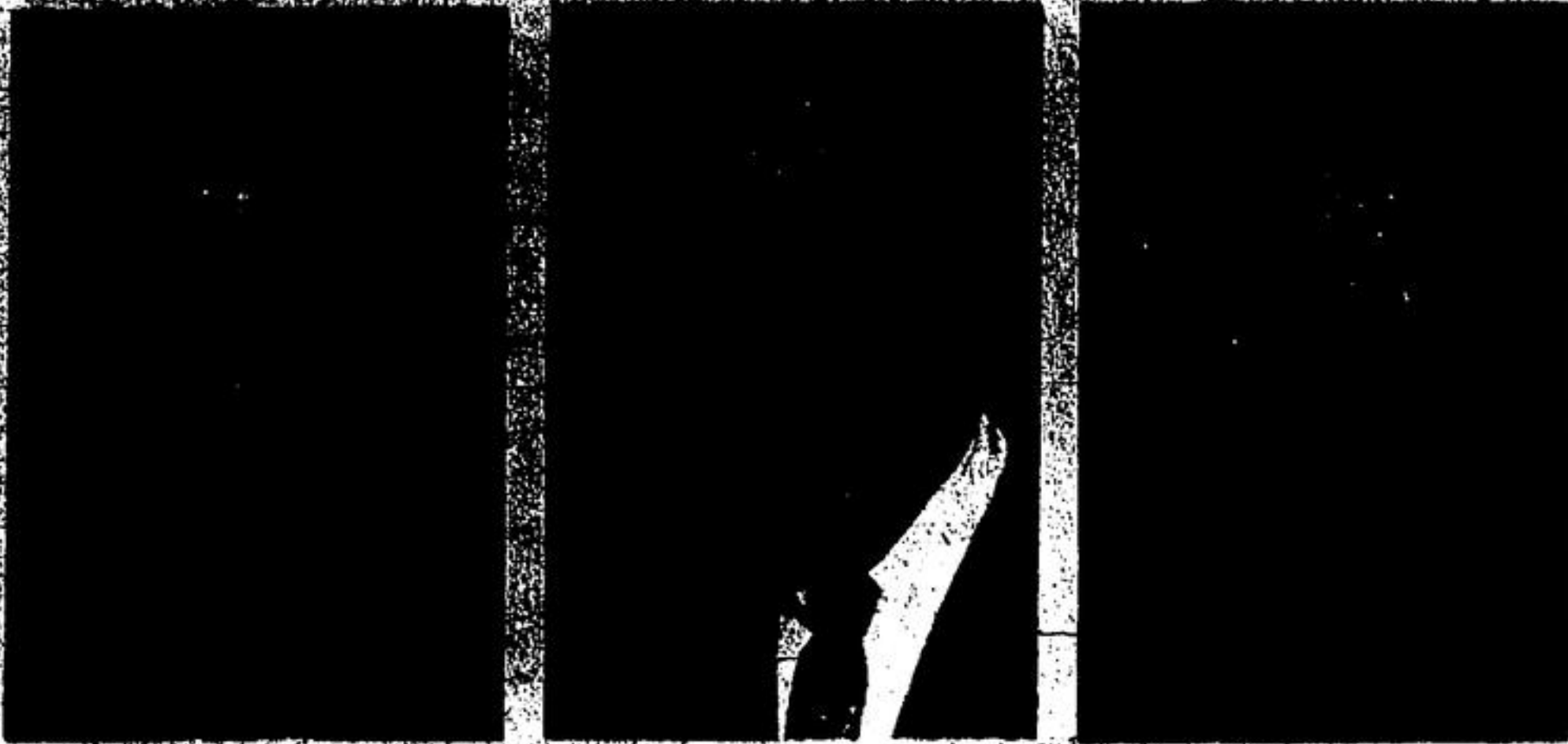


Nine candidates seek seats on Nassagaweya school board

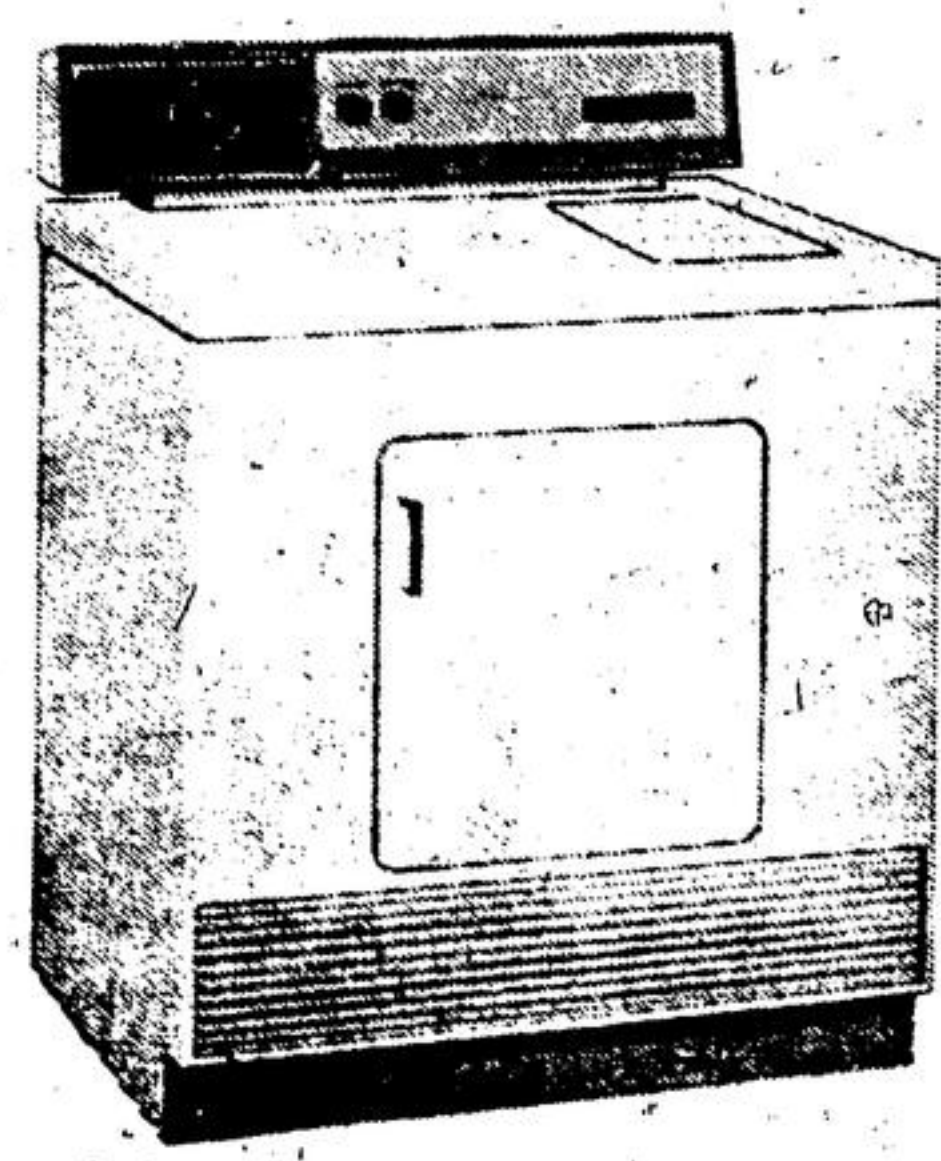
