are hit by insects By Henry J. Stanley With the warm, moist weather during the past few weeks, insects are more abundant than normal on evergreens and shrubs. Aphids — the soft-bodied insects that suck sap out of the leaves on many trees, shrubs and flowers, can be everyone enjoyed the happy controlled with Malathion. Leaf miners, which eat between the upper and lower surfaces of leaves, should be sprayed with

Lindane of Cygon-2E. As an alternative to spray-16a1-tf ing. Cygon-2E can be painted around the trunk or stem of the plant. The first generation of these insects will not be controlled, but it will help to

control the next. Mites are very prevalent in white cedar. These very small insectss can be identified by a very fine webbing throughout, the foliage on the cedar, as they suck the sap from the foliage and the cedar dies. Malathion can also be used for




