Treatment vital part of TB campaign

The Christmas Seal Campaign is well underway, with 32,000 letters mailed to Haltion county residents. The board of directors met recently in Milton to plan the annual drive.

The monumental job of filling envelopes with campaign material was undertaken by a group of 106 students of Thomas A. Blakelock High School, Oakville, under the direction of the principal, Hugh Brearley, himself a director of the Association. All funds administered by the TB Association are raised through the Christmas Seal Campaign.

A donation of \$1,000 to the World Health Organization was announced at the meeting. This grant was directed for the purchase of BCG injections for children in a developing country infected with TB, to be used at the discretion of Dr. Mahlar, a director of the TB section of the WHO. The extent of the usefulness of such a donation can be realized with the cost of an injection for one child being only five cents. This protection may be used anywhere in the world.

During the meeting it was again stressed that TB is really far from being under control, that many cases are still being detected and treated in Sanatoria throughout Canada and the world. Statistics show that approximately half the world's population is in some way affected by TB, with the disease rampant in some underdeveloped countries.

Dr. L. M. Stuart, assistant M.O.H. for Haltion County, reported the recent discovery of three active cases of TB in one family in the neighborhood. Besides treatment of active cases, it also results in exhaustive investigation of all individuals coming in contact with the infected children.

Fortunately in this country, largely as a result of efforts of the TB organizations supporting the medical profession, discovery of active cases usually results in early treatment and cure and a much shorter confinement in hospital than was at one time necessary.
