Acton council passed a resolution at their last regular meeting authorizing renewal of fire agreements with Esquesing, Nassagaweya and Erin townships for a three year period. The Acton fire brigade provides fire protection in specified areas of all three townships.

Councillor Bob Drinkwater said the matter was done thoroughly. "Firefighters requested no adjustments this year. No radical changes are expected over the next three years and the Acton firefighters felt their contract was reasonable."
