To the Council and Ratepayers of the Town of Acton, Ontario. Dear Sirs: We have made an examination of the books and accounts of the Town of Acton and its associated boards and commissions for the year ended December 31, 1967. Our examination has been conducted in accordance with the auditing instructions of the Department of Municipal Affairs and there is attached a completed questionnaire covering this.

The statement of Revenue and Expenditure "D" shows a surplus on the year's operations of \$6,734.16 and there is attached statement of assets and liabilities from the budget showing how this surplus arose.

AUDITOR'S OPINION We hereby report that in our opinion: (1) The financial transactions which have come under our notice have been within the powers of the Municipality.

(2) The audit has been conducted in accordance with the instructions of the Department of Municipal Affairs. (3) The financial statements present fairly the financial position of the Municipality as at December 31, 1967 and the results of its operations for the year ended on that date.
