Lack of water was blamed for the shutdown of Smith and Stone one Thursday afternoon.

When the present system is running at capacity slightly over two million gallons is pumped daily. Early June saw peak pumping periods just meeting the needs.

Councillor John Hole urged plans be prepared for a fifth well, in view of the situation.
