Greenock W.I. meeting in form of family picnic

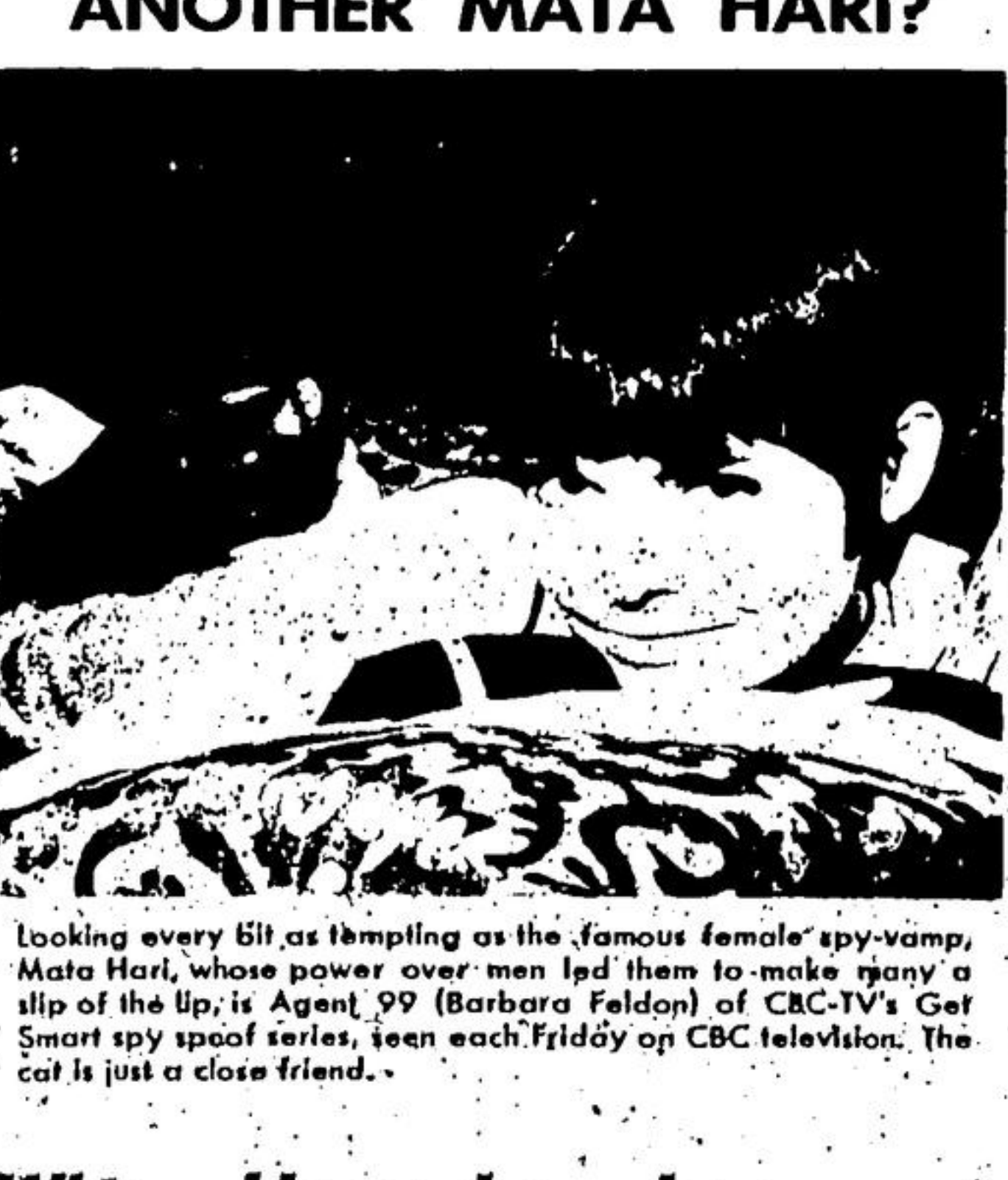
