Mayor Joe Gibbons retires

GEORGETOWN—Mayor Joe Gibbons dropped a "bombshell" by announcing he would not seek re-election following a council meeting last week.

Mayor Gibbons told the astonished group he was completing 22 years' service to Georgetown, four years as a councillor and 18 years as mayor.

The veteran politician warned council he might be back in five or 10 years to straighten things out if they make a mess of things. Mayor Gibbons' current stretch in office started in December, 1963, when he resigned as assessment commissioner to return to political life after an absence of several years.

He first served on council in 1931 representing Ward One. His first term as mayor was in 1934 and he retained the office for an unprecedented 10-year period.

Mayor Gibbons is a native of the Acton district. Meanwhile, Councillor Wheldon (Steamer) Emmerson announced he would be a candidate for mayor ensuring at least a three man race for the post. Other candidates are Councillor Robert Francis and John Elliott.

Plan modern shopping centre

MILTON—Plans for a modern 20 to 22 store shopping centre and a possible 100 to 165 suite apartment building on Bronte St. were revealed this week by an official of a Toronto real estate firm.

A private builder is planning to erect a large shopping centre on the property lying between Heslop Rd. and Anne Blvd. on the east side of Bronte St., on lands presently zoned for commercial use.

Two supermarkets, furniture stores, variety and drug firms and others have expressed interest and the realtor has had so many enquiries from doctors, lawyers and professional people they are considering a second store of professional offices.

The same firm has an apartment project which will be presented for Milton Planning Board's consideration later this month. A modern building featuring underground parking, steam rooms and sauna baths is planned. Mr. Swartz said a building with 100 suites in the seven storey range is deemed ideal, although the firm has considered an apartment with 165 suites.

Back in the khaki days

FERGUS—Writing in his weekly column in The Fergus News—Record Hugh Templin reminisces about his days in the army during the first world war:

"I was in the Cyclists, but we could not ride bikes in the deep snow. We marched through the streets near the Exhibition. The people greeted us with enthusiasm. I remember one woman who came out to the sidewalk shouting "Good luck to the boys of the allies!" What she meant was "Allies". That was the title of a song. She made up an enthusiasm for her errors. I remember one day a storekeeper invited our whole company in for soft drinks. That was his contribution to the winning of the war.

"We had two young lieutenants who came from London and liked to toboggan. They used to march us out to High Park where we stood around while they tobogganed. Then they march us back to the Exhibition."
