Expand Authority

The jurisdiction of the Grand River Conservation Authority has been expanded to take in three more municipalities, bringing the total number of municipalities in the watershed to 74. The three new ones are the townships of Glanford, Ancaster and Walpole.

Most of the smaller, rural municipalities have been re-grouped into 10 groups for representation. Prior to this there were 14 groups of small municipalities.

Representation for some of the larger expanding municipalities has also been increased. Kitchener, Brantford and Guelph now each have three representatives, instead of two. When all municipalities have selected their representatives, the authority will have 34 members.

Under the old legislation, municipalities selected their representatives, and they in turn selected directors to the authority.

Municipalities in this area in group five are Esquesing, Nasagaweya, Elm, Eramosa, Puslinch, West Garafraxa and Guelph township and the town of Fergus. This group has two representatives.
