## What council did

At their final meeting for 1968, Acton Council:

• Heard Mayor Les Duly recommend council think seriously of purchasing a snow blower.

• Agreed not to oppose a United Gas application to the Ontario Energy Board for a change in billing procedure.

• Authorized the clerk-administrator to issue cheques to cover financial statement No. 12 of \$12,012.89.

• Passed a resolution to accept a quotation of \$1850 for a new sander. The committee recommendation that it be purchased with funds from the Town Equipment Account was accepted. Questioned by the reeve who felt council could not legally make the purchase, at this time, the mayor and deputy-reeve said the amount was in an existing account which made it permissible though legislation prohibited spending money from new sources. The account is kept to purchase equipment.

• Passed a resolution authorizing committee minutes to be issued to the press "to allow more accurate presentation of council."

• Heard a plea from the outgoing reeve for a sidewalk snow removal program and also removal of snow from driveways from the sidewalk to the street. Council agreed to consider a sidewalk removal program but felt removal of snow from the front end of driveways was an expensive operation tailored only for large municipalities.
