Action Line on 6th line drainage

The Toronto Telegram's Action Line is the latest thorn in the side of Esqueving councilors, demanding township intervention in drainage problems along the Sixth Line. In a letter to the Telegram, residents complained of an open ditch of stagnant water on the property of Miss St. Jean at R.R. 3 Georgetown. Improper drainage on both sides of the road creates an unpleasant odour, a health hazard and a potential threat to children, they said.

"It's a civic matter between the neighbors and Miss St. Jean," suggested Councilor Ken Marshall. Reeve Currie agreed. "This ditch is on private property and there's nothing we can do about it."
