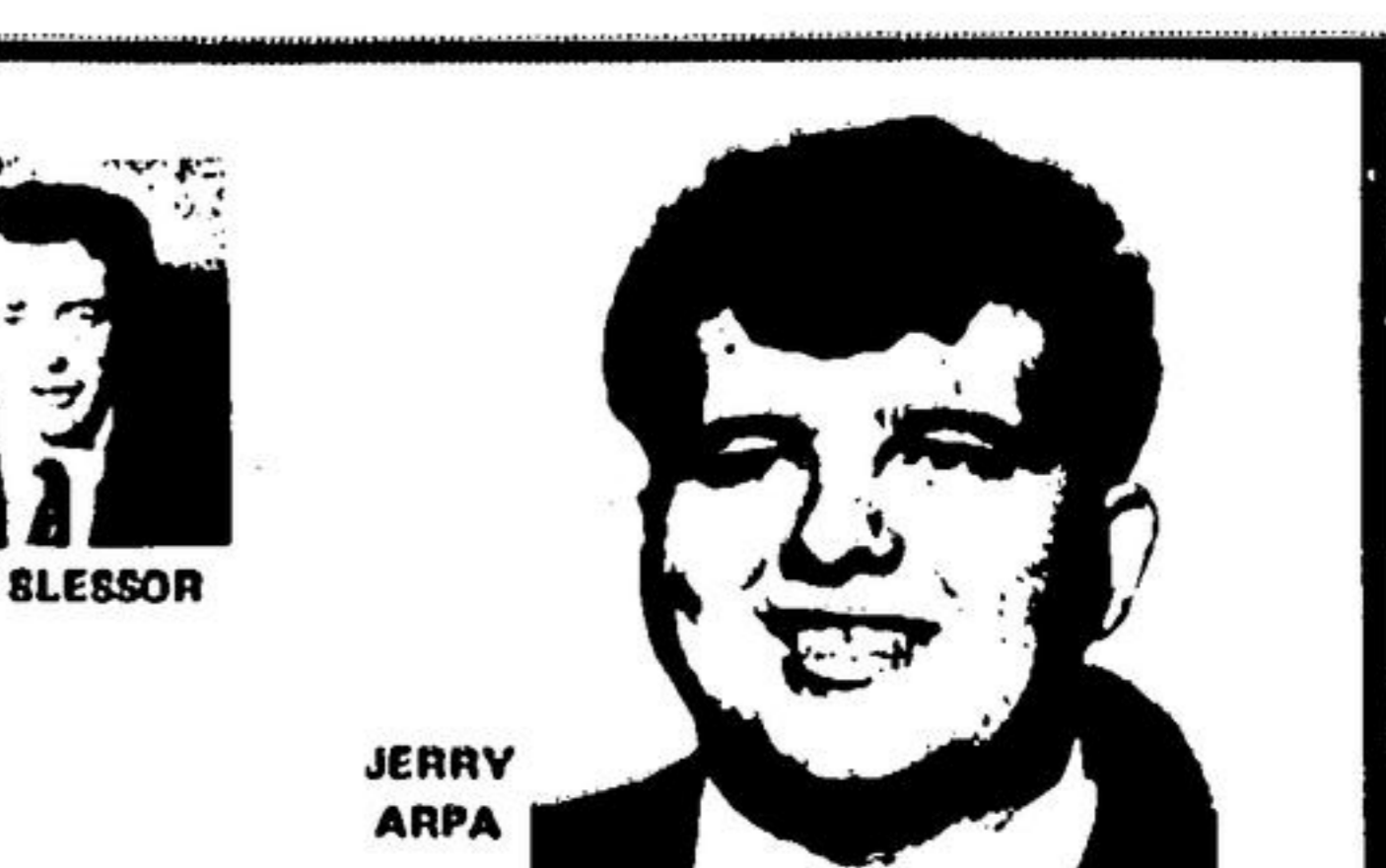
PEEWEEES
