Notice to Residents of Acton

Excerpts from Town of Acton By-Law 69-1460

A By-law for establishing and maintaining a system for the collection, removal and disposal of refuse, garbage and other refuse within the municipality of the Town of Acton.

10. Receptacles used to contain garbage, rubbish, ashes or other waste material to be collected by the Town of Acton shall be covered water-tight containers not more than 30 inches high or 18 inches wide and shall not weigh more than 50 pounds when full. Containers must have handles or be clear of grease or other material detrimental to handling. Receptacles which are smaller than the top than at the bottom, such as five gallon paint cans, shall not be used. The preceding section of this paragraph shall not apply where the container is to be disposed of with the contents except that it shall not weigh over 50 pounds. No more than five containers shall be picked up at one time from each landlord or tenant. (Council is aware that the limit of five containers may be restrictive in certain cases but requests the co-operation of the landlord or tenant in maintaining this number as standard procedure.)

12. Garbage must be drained of all liquid and securely wrapped in paper before being placed in receptacles.

13. Such articles as crates, newspapers, packing materials, brush, bedding, old furniture and material of like nature may be collected in like manner as garbage and ashes, but must be securely tied into compact bundles or parcels not exceeding 2 1/2 feet in any dimension or weighing over 50 pounds or placed in sufficient receptacles as specified in Clause 10 herein so that they will not be scattered.

15. It is the responsibility of the householder to place garbage material for collection at the prescribed location prior to collection but not before 8:00 p.m. on the previous day.

17. Empty receptacles and all material which the collector refused must be removed from the highway or from public property by the householder of the premises from which it taken, before 8:00 p.m. on the same day that the garbage is collected or the material refused.

18. Material set out for collection shall normally be placed as close as possible to the edge of the roadway without obstructing the roadway, sidewalk or footpath.
