A PERSONAL MATTER.

It will have leaked around town before this that the editor of this influential sheet was nominated for the Mayoralty, along with others, at the special nomination held last Friday. We never had even the remotest thought of becoming a candidate for the honorable office until it was suggested to us by men who have long been active and forward in municipal matters in this municipality and whose reputation standing and judgment are unquestioned. We had declined the request to be nominated at the beginning of this year, and, after some little thought, we decided our nomination to be made last Friday. This was not done, however, without first consulting Mr. MacKenzie, who, we had understood, would be nominated. From him, we were given to understand that if we (the editor "we") could get the office without an election, he would be glad to see us get it, and that if only he and the editor of the Herald were nominated, the former would decline for the latter. This was indeed kind of Mr. MacKenzie. But for reasons best known to himself—perfectly good we doubt not, for a moment—at the close of the nomination, when he was one of the only two candidates, he was quite unwilling to do as we plainly understood—he intended to do at the conference what he did at the nomination—that Mr. MacKenzie was to be not an approver, but an opponent, we would not, under the circumstances, when nobly winter the bother of an election, have consented to have our name mentioned in connection with the Mayoralty. With those considerations in view it was with some hesitancy—that we declined the almost relentless pressure of friends, on the day succeeding nomination to make a contest. We have no desire for office and had no desire for it on this occasion. We entered the field in good faith for reasons above stated, and we leave the way clear for Mr. MacKenzie as above stated, and congratulate him upon former occasions at the hands of the electors of this municipality.
