Safety First.

Officers and employees of the Grand Trunk Railway are trying by every means in their power to prevent injuries to all persons, especially to children, but in looking into this subject they find that more than half of all persons killed or injured in the United States are killed while trespassing on railway property. In this way in that country fifteen thousand persons are killed and about the same number are injured for every day in the year.

Perhaps you may think that the 11,000 or more persons killed or injured every year while trespassing on railway property is a great number, but the fact is that so few of them are killed or injured. Most walking on tracks, running across places of work or business, children playing on the tracks or flipping cars, putting the greater part of the blame on the driver.

Those injured and killed in this way are not the only ones who suffer. Their families being deprived of their services and support, the hospital and the large share of the burden. The public is well privy of the service of this large company and its great percentage of care and maintenance of such persons and dependent families of those families in the community.

In the interest of public safety, every one is earnestly requested not to walk on or along railroad tracks both on account of the danger of being run over and causing a good example to others. We ask parents to call this subject to the attention of their children, and teach them as to the danger of walking on and about the tracks and of flipping cars.

In this connection we also call to the attention of all drivers of automobiles, it is quite common, due to failure of persons to stop and look in both directions for oncoming traffic before crossing a track at highway and other places. No member that travels may move on the tracks and walk on them. We do not have any person so foolish as to do this. Let us take the few seconds before crossing a track to make sure that there is no approaching train. If all drivers would "look under" crossing gates or cross tracks when warned to do so by signs from agents or other sources,
