SOME BASEBALL RECORDS

Big Boston Season in the Modern His-
tory of the Game.

In the early days of baseball white-
washing a team was one of the most
essential qualities of the game. The
ball was so lively, with plenty of
batter between the covers, the pitcher's
delivery so restricted and the batting
owing to the portable foundation
building, we knew that to prevent a team
from scoring was considered almost
impossible. They score runs the way
modern people score runs.

Because of the radical changes in the
rules of the game it would be rather
misleading to measure present stand-
ards with the models set up in "an-
cient days." Modern baseball history
begins in 1850.

In the major league (National League
and American Association) the highest
score has been registered in the an-
cient days—250 in 1850, 24
