**FOOD PRODUCTION VITAL TO VICTORY**

The progress made by the reorganization of Economic Committees in the general campaign which is being pursued by the Provincial Government to increase food production, is reflected in a special circular issued by the committee and which is practically an inventory of the machinery which the committee has set in motion to achieve their objectives. The committee aims first to increase production on the farm by the use of methods which involve a minimum of extra labor. This is being done by facilitating the use of tractor implements, through the Department of Agriculture, and the spread of knowledge of more intensive agricultural methods. The problems of increased acreage and increased labor facilities are being met together in the sum of the committee's efforts, and they now have completed a labor organization which, drawing from High Schools, colleges, offices and factories, should provide a sufficient amount of manual labor during the growing season to give a reasonably effective impetus towards greater food production within the province. Employment bureaus have been opened in Toronto, Ottawa, Hamilton and London and each of the district representatives of the Department of Agriculture is acting as agent for the labor exchange which is under the charge of Dr. W. A. Hiddell, superintendent of the Trades and Labor Branch of the Department of Public Works. The sympathetic cooperation of the farmer is the crux of the question. To gain this the committee is endeavoring, through the district representatives of the Department of Agriculture and through practical farmers, throughout the province, to impress upon the farmer the great fact that the need of the nation calls for more on the farm this year than the quality as shall show that the man on the farm are back of the man at arms.
