CHANCES ARE that before long we will all be eating Johnny Cake and potatoes—and glad to get 'em for it begins to look as if we are going to have a good many of our luxuries curtailed and what we save will have to go into war bonds. Well, I don't know but what it will be a good thing for us all if we have to reduce. Most men were eating too much, anyway, and making a god out of one's stomach isn't a good thing for individuals or nations. The knowledge that less food was helping to win the war would perhaps bring it home to some people more than it has been brought home in the past, and how trivial anything we are asked to do is in comparison with the heroic things the men in the trenches are doing daily.

ANY PERSON in Canada failing to register on the day set apart by the Dominion Government for the registration of everyone between 18 and 60 will expose himself to serious penalties and disabilities. He may be fined or imprisoned, or at the discretion of the court he may be both fined and sentenced to imprisonment. He will forfeit any right he may otherwise have had to vote at a Dominion election. He will be disqualified to receive any wages or salary, to obtain board or lodging at any hotel restaurant or boarding house, or to purchase a ticket for to travel upon any railroad or steamboat. Any person knowing him to be unregistered, who gives him board or lodging or who sells him transportation or any conductor, captain, purser or other officer who, knowing him to be unregistered permits him to proceed upon a journey, will thereby render himself liable to heavy penalties.
