Scale's Accuracy.

Seemed a Singular Thing Until Ex-
planation Dropped on the Pair
Who Were Going Through the
Regular Program.

"We keep," said Mr. Billtops, "a
record of Mrs. Billtops's weight. There
is a drug store in our neighborhood
which we pass in our daily walks
where they have a nice beam scale,
and about once in ten days or two

record."

time her lighter-weight spring coat,
we ran into a regular incident."

"After weighing her, as usual, with
her coat on, we remembered that we
had forgotten to weigh this coat be-
fore starting out, but this was a light
coat that could be easily removed and
handed, and so now Mrs. Billtops
removed her coat and we weighed her
with her coat off as she did with it on."

"Mrs. Billtops and I looked at each
other in mild amazement; but then at
the same moment we both made the
same discovery. Still standing on the
scale, Mrs. Billtops was holding the
coat she had just removed!"

"I am not sure that Mrs. Billtops is
quite as much interested in all this
weighing business as I am, but we
both laugh at that; and really I
should say that taking everything to-
gether we get a lot of fun out of weigh-
ing Mrs. Billtops."—New York Times.
