King Appoints Day for Empire Peace Celebration.

Ottawa, July 6.—The Government has received from the Colonial Secretary two despatches dated July 1, which are now made public. His Majesty has issued a proclamation appointing Sunday the sixth day of July as a day of General Thanksgiving for the blessing of peace, and it is his desire that this day shall be observed not only in the United Kingdom, but in all parts of the Empire. The king has also given his sanction to a peace celebration in the United Kingdom on Saturday, July 19, and the hope is expressed that all parts of the Empire will join as far as possible in celebrating peace on that day.
