

### By-Law No. --

#### A BY-LAW TO AID SMITH & STONE LIMITED BY EXEMPTING THEIR PROPERTY FROM TAXATION AND PROVIDING THEM WITH WATER FREE OF CHARGE FOR A PERIOD OF TEN YEARS, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNCIL OF THIS CORPORATION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SAID COMPANY FOR THAT PURPOSE.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Georgetown deem it desirable to aid SMITH & STONE LIMITED by exempting their property from taxation and providing them with free water upon the terms and conditions set forth in the agreement hereinafter referred to, which forms part of this by-law.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the whole debt of the said Corporation amounting to the sum of \$50,807.62 (exclusive of local improvement debts) and no portion of the principal or interest is in arrears.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Corporation of the Village of Georgetown enacts as follows:

1. The Corporation of the Village of Georgetown may make and enter into an agreement with SMITH & STONE LIMITED as hereinafter set forth and forms part of this by-law and the Reeve and Clerk of the said Municipality are hereby authorized and empowered to sign and execute the said agreement and the Clerk of the Corporation is hereby authorized and authorized to affix corporate seal to the said agreement.

2. Upon the said Corporation complying with the terms and conditions thereof for a period of ten years from January 1st, 1911, the Corporation's lands and premises described in the said agreement shall be entirely exempt from all Municipal taxation by the said Corporation either in respect of the said lands or any part thereof or any improvements now or hereafter made or erected thereon for the purposes of the said business, but not for dwelling houses or residential purposes or in respect of any business carried on upon the said lands in pursuance of the said agreement, or in respect of any income derived therefrom.

3. This by-law (in the event of the assent of the electors being obtained thereon) shall take effect from the date of the final passing and ratification thereof.

#### AGREEMENT

Referred to in By-Law above written

THIS INDENTURE made in duplicate, this 6th day of October, 1910, BETWEEN SMITH & STONE LIMITED, a Company incorporated under the provisions of THE ONTARIO COMPANIES ACT hereinafter called the Corporation, OF THE FIRST PART, AND THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, hereinafter called the Corporation, OF THE SECOND PART.

WHEREAS the parties hereto are desirous that the Company should carry on its business for the first three years of its existence for each working day and for the remaining nine years an average of twenty employees for each working day and shall pay in wages to their employees for the first year an average of not less than \$100.00 per week and for the remaining nine years an average of not less than \$100.00 per week unless prevented from so doing by accident, fire, strike, or other unavoidable cause, in which event the calculations as to the number of employees to be employed and the sum of money to be paid in wages shall be made as hereinafter provided.

3. All the said employees shall be residents of the said Village of Georgetown.

4. In the event of fire, accident, strike, or any other unavoidable cause which shall cause such an interruption then in such case operations shall be resumed as soon as possible thereafter and until business is resumed the Company shall be relieved pro tanto of its undertaking to employ the number of employees and to pay the wages hereinbefore set out.

5. The Company shall have the right to shut down the factory for

two weeks during each calendar year during the said period for the purpose of taking stock of making repairs and during the said period of two weeks the Company shall be relieved pro tanto of its undertaking to employ the number of employees and to pay the quantity of wages hereinafter set out.

During the said period the said Company shall be entirely exempt from all Municipal taxation by the said Corporation either in respect of the said lands or any part thereof or any improvements now or hereafter to be made or erected thereon for the purposes of the said business, but not for dwelling houses or residential purposes or in respect of any business carried on upon the said lands in pursuance of the said agreement, or in respect of any income derived therefrom.

7. If the Corporation should make default under this agreement then the Company shall thereupon become liable to pay the Corporation all taxes and water rates which would have been chargeable against the Company if this agreement had not been made and then and thereupon this agreement shall become null and void.

8. The Corporation shall pass such by-laws as may be necessary to carry out the terms of this agreement from time to time and shall when and if necessary have the same ratified, sanctioned and approved by the ratepayers and unless so ratified, sanctioned and approved by the ratepayers this agreement shall be null and void.

#### SCHEDULE "A"

ALL AND WHOLLY those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate being and being partly in the Village of Georgetown and partly in the Township of Eglarston, all in the County of Halton and Province of Ontario and being composed of four acres and more or less of the north east half of Lot Number Nineteen in the Ninth Concession of the Township of Georgetown, and two and 88-100 acres of Lot Number Twenty, in the Ninth Concession in the said Township of Georgetown, as shown on registered Plan 132 of the County of Halton; and those north forty-five degrees and eleven minutes west two and 88-100 acres of Lot Number Twenty-three as shown on P. And that the 17th day of November, A.D., 1910, at five o'clock in the afternoon at the Town Hall in the said Municipality has been fixed for the appointment of persons to attend at the said polling place and at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk.

And that if the assent of the electors is obtained to the said proposed by-law it will be taken into consideration by the Municipal Council of the said Corporation at a meeting thereunto to be held after the expiration of one month from the date of the first publication of this notice, and that such first publication was made on the twenty-ninth day of October, A.D., 1910.
