MEN WE MUST ADMIRE THEY PROTECT LAW AND ORDER IN YOUNG COUNTRY. The Royal Northwest Mounted Police Have Been Mustered Out of Service After Making a Record That Cannot Be Matched in the History of Modern Pioneer Undertakings Under Any Flag.

The famous Northwest Mounted Police has been mustered out of service. For half a century, the Scarlet and Gold of the wilderness has been a symbol of law and order. And the territory they patrolled is as vast as the United States west of the Mississippi. On the prairie, in mountains and forest, through the ice-bound reaches of Arctic coast, they made the "long patrol," protecting the settler, supporting the weak and upholding justice with a fearless hand to Indian and white man, to British and alien. The territory covered by the Royal Northwest Mounted Police has now reached a policy in the history of a different form of policing is called for. The many provinces which at the inception of this famous corps were populated by hunters, trappers and Indians, have been thickly settled by farmers, merchants and professional men. And these provinces have formed their separate laws for governing, which are not in harmony with the law and order as carried out by the "Scarlet and Gold" of the wilderness. It is now merged with the Canadian Mounted Police.

Only in the far north in any of the original work of the police left here in the Great Barrons, along the desolate shores of Hudson Bay and the Arctic Ocean, through the Rockies to Dawson, the "long patrol" will be needed. But the famous corps has done its work and has lost its identity in the new national force. The uniform has been preserved, but the old romance has disappeared. For nearly two centuries the Hudson Bay Company had ruled that vast territory between Hudson Bay and the Rockies, when in 1870 the Dominion of Canada gained possession. The great company which had been guardian to the wild like Blackfoot, Assiniboines and Cree Indians, had kept in a fashion law and order. The hardy Scotch and English men in many instances married into the tribes, and their influence was powerful and firm. The chief of the company in control. It became a "no-man's land," with the great company without authority and the Dominion Government without any machinery to enforce its edicts. It was a dangerous period. The United States Government was seeking to curb the fierce Sioux. They in turn, were making overtures to the Canadian Indians to join them. The whiskey runner was unchecked in his debauchery of the Indian. It was at this period that the Royal Northwest Mounted Police was first organized, and since then have been the most potent influence in preserving order in this vast territory. Three companies were mobilized at Winnipeg, or as it was then known, "Fort Gary." Three other companies joined them later. In all, 1,050 men restored and preserved order in a territory as large as Europe, without a rifle, bayonet, or other arms, with 100,000 Indians, rest with tribal wars and embittered against the whites by the depredations of the buffalo herds, the almost sole source of their existence.

It was then that the famous "scarlet and gold" uniform was adopted. To the Indian the "red" coat symbolized the power of the Great White Mother, and the white of the Rockies, and the gold of the Rockies. In the last fifty years they have brought the Indian into treaty, have made the "white" runner or whiskey runner only a name, and in the last few years that keeping mining camp of Dawson was as safe as an eastern hamlet. During the regime of the river, Canada's western dome, the backbone of the country, of trial and tribulation, the railway stage, when the first continental war was across the prairie without provoking strife with the original owners of the country, to the period of peaceful settlement and the rebuilding of modern cities.
