

**THE NEW Canadian cent pieces** are beginning to make their appearance. They are much smaller than the one cent pieces now in use, being only slightly larger and thicker than the United States cent, and somewhat larger still than the Canadian ten cent piece. The new coins are noticeably lighter than the old-fashioned cents, due not only to the reduction in size but also to a fractional variation in the copper content in the alloy of which they are composed. The design adopted is very attractive. At any rate, British and Canadian coins look better to us than those of the United States. Perhaps it is because we like the emblem better, but they also look newer and more artistic.

**PULSING ABUNDANCE OF WHOLESOME AMUSEMENT**

While the Canadian National Exhibition is designed to provide an object lesson in the making and keeping of Canadian and British citizenship, and as a stimulus to the advancement of the Arts, Sciences and the mighty forces of industry, the lighter side is not neglected. The programme here as in all other departments is far more ambitious in elaboration of plans and in investment of capital than has been the case in any preceding. Over \$75,000 is being spent on two new amusement devices alone.
