A New Coal Order
The Ontario Fuel Controller is issuing instructions to all coal dealers that they must first secure a declaration from the consumer that he has not on hand sufficient coal for the winter before he can deliver any further coal. These notices are also being sent to the mayors and Reeves of all municipalities. More nonsensical red tape. If the controller would put his efforts to stimulating the supply the suffering public could see the need of this official.

THE TENDENCY of to-day to call things by their right names has reached the fur trade, and the Canadian Government has been requested to introduce legislation prohibiting the use of inaccurate or misleading names for furs. If the law passed, there will be no more "Hudson" or "Baltic" seal; it will become "sealed muskrat," or "seal muskrat," or "seal-dyed muskrat," but the lordly seal will be turned into the humble muskrat. Any "near seal" and "electric seal" will become "seal-dyed rabbit" and "Alaska sable" and "black marten" will turn into the malodorous skunk, and will be known as "sable dyed skunk" or "marten-dyed skunk." These furs will be no better nor worse for the change, but at least we shall know what the furs really are.
