would be trivial compared with the service they would receive. The garage and paper could be burned in an incinerator and the incombustible materials, such as old cans, stove pipes, etc., could be placed in a dump provided for that purpose. Accommodation should be provided in the Fire Hall for the horses and driver at night.

Many other points with regard to the erection of buildings, the occupancy of buildings, etc., should be governed by the by-laws of the town. Provision has apparently never been made for the control of the erection and occupancy and inspection of buildings.

Where valuable properties and the livelihood of citizens are at stake it is foolish to play with fire, and yet that is what is being done every day. The selected open fires are set out as a convenience, and food for a conflagration is being allowed to accumulate in attics and cellars, under stairways and in backyards.

Thorough and frequent inspections should be made by an official appointed by the Municipal Council, but such inspections cannot be effective until there is a proper set of by-laws to definitely govern such inspections. If the Council will encourage the citizens to the extent that I have recommended, we are convinced that they will make your town a safer, more beautiful and healthier place in which to live.

Fairs Advertise You

To the general farmer who grows good grain and seed, to the specialist in garden and truck crops, and particularly to the live stock man, the fall fair offers an opportunity. It pays to advertise; the fair is the place where the people see the goods produced, and seeing is believing. Moreover, the papers report the winnings, and though the exhibitor will get a large amount of advertising free which would otherwise cost him a considerable amount of money. Winning in close competitions under a competent judge adds dollars to the value of stock shown and increases the market price of any commodity, as well as giving the exhibitor a standing not only in his own community, but over a section of country corresponding to the size and influence of the show at which prizes are won. The fair is a good place to make sales. Prospective buyers see the good exhibits made and acquire the desire to buy at home. Stockmen show at fairs largely to make sales rather than to win prizes, although the latter is a factor in the sales and they are not disappointed as evidenced by the growing interest in the fall fair. Showing at the fair, coupled with a judicious newspaper advertising policy, which should never be neglected, is good business. The two go together and work hand in hand. It pays to let others know of your good stock.



The Fire Ranger and His Job



DOTTED over 100,000,000 acres of forest, 1,000 men, organized in the employ of the Government of Ontario, are this summer, passing back and forth over the canoe routes and along the railways, watching out for the tell-tale smoke which is the sign of fire. Regardless of hot weather, rain, snow, sleet, blizzards, loneliness or monotony, the Fire Rangers make his rounds, preventing, quenching or fighting fires in Ontario's forests, paying his own living and travel expenses, and receiving \$2.00 per day for his services.

All in all, the Ontario Fire Ranger is entitled to the help and co-operation of everyone. He deserves to be supported by the people of Ontario can give him. His work is vital importance. Heed his warnings. Do what he asks.

Save Ontario's Forests They're Yours

The Ontario Fire Ranger, during the dangerous period of the dry summer, is constantly on patrol to catch fires while they are still small. He comes to prevent them starting, as a rule. He is at the moment of all times most useful in the prevention of forest fires.

A host of Ontario's Fire Rangers are northern woodsmen, common to common men, only five per cent of them are students, and these are experienced Fire Rangers or returned soldiers.

Rangers travel chiefly by canoe and in pairs over a definite "beat," the length of which varies according to the degree of danger from fires.

Others travel up and down the forested railway sections on horseback, following trains to put out fires set by timber looters. In all, 2,100 miles of railroad are patrolled steadily all summer.

Two men devote their whole time to examining locomotives to see that screens and ashpans will not permit the escape of sparks and live coal. In the clay belt, a large force of Rangers supervise settlers' fires in land-clearing operations.

Don't blame the Fire Ranger if he asks you to be careful. Don't think he is too particular. He knows the risk. Ontario is poor by world millions of dollars through forest fires in the past. Help the Fire Ranger save the increasingly valuable forests that remain.
