

By-Law No.

Of the Corporation of the Village of Georgetown to provide for the issue of debentures for the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars for the construction of a Waterworks System in and for the Village of Georgetown as an auxiliary system to the present system already established in the said municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to construct a waterworks system as an auxiliary system to the system already established in the said municipality together with the necessary machinery and plant therefore for the purpose of supplying water for domestic use, fire protection and other purposes according to plans and estimates prepared by the Engineers, Civil and Sanitary Engineers.

AND WHEREAS the said plan of said proposed system of waterworks has been approved by the Provincial Board of Health and such approval has been certified to in writing and signed by the Chairman and Secretary of the Board;

AND WHEREAS the total estimated cost of the said waterworks, with the necessary machinery and plant therefore and necessary land required and right of way, has been estimated at \$40,000.00 and forth in the estimated cost appears hereto under the head of Schedule One;

AND WHEREAS in order to provide for the said sum of \$40,000.00 it will be necessary to issue debentures of the said Corporation of the Village of Georgetown for the sum of \$60,000.00 hereinafter provided which is the amount of the debt to be created by this by-law; the proceeds of the said debentures to be applied for the purpose aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to issue the said debentures and date and to make the principal of said debt repayable in yearly sums during a period of thirty years being the currency of the said debentures, said yearly sum being \$1,000.00, the amount of the said debt and interest is \$425,000.00;

AND WHEREAS the total amount required by the Municipal Act and any amendments thereto, to be raised annually by special rate for paying the said debt and interest is \$425,000.00;

AND WHEREAS the amount of the said debentures, debt of the said Corporation of the Village of Georgetown is \$50,000.00 and no principal or interest in respect thereof is in arrears;

He it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Georgetown:

That is shall be lawful for the Corporation to rent or purchase such rights of way, lands and buildings, waters and privileges as may be necessary to enable the said Corporation to construct and maintain a system of waterworks, together with all buildings, machinery and plant therefor, as may be required for the purpose aforesaid, to be situated in the said municipality subject to the provisions of the Municipal Act, and any amendment thereto, and of the Public Utilities Commission, and to let, hire and contract and subject to any law of the Corporation lawfully to be passed relating thereto;

It shall be lawful for the said Corporation to rent or purchase such rights of way, lands and buildings, waters and privileges as may be necessary to enable the said Corporation to construct and maintain a system of waterworks, such rights of way, lands and buildings, machinery and equipment therefor, as may be required to be constructed and maintained within the said corporation;

For the purpose aforesaid in the present case shall be borrowed on the credit of the Corporation the sum of sixty thousand dollars and debentures shall be issued therefore on the credit of the Merchant's Bank in the amount of \$60,000.00 or not less than one hundred dollars each which shall have coupons attached thereto for the payment of interest at six per cent. and shall bear interest from the date of issue until paid within two years after the date on which this by-law is passed and may bear any date within such two years and shall bear interest from the date of issue until paid when they shall be issued and shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent. per annum, payable yearly in arrears. Interest shall be charged during the thirty years next after the date when they shall be issued and the respective amounts payable in each of such years shall be as follows:

The coupons shall be signed by the Treasurer of the said municipality and the Clerk of the said municipality shall countersign the same.
