**OTTAWA.**  
Where Canada's Capital Got Its Unusual Name.  
A fine old Indian word is perpetuated in the name of Ottawa's capital city. The word is derived from an Indian word, meaning "the place of the aboriginal and numerous other tribes," "adawa," meaning "to trade." The Ottawa were great traders, bartering in furs and corn and similar necessities of the aboriginal life. For their trading expeditions they made the river that now divides Quebec and Ontario their chief artery of traffic, and even went so far as to claim ownership of the river, naming it after themselves.  
Early visitors to Chaudiere Falls and the big river found that the Ottawa was already named. There were plenty of such visitors from Montreal and Quebec. In 1613, Champlain first called the Ottawa, in 1628, Nicholas Galvani, a clerk in the service of the Company of One Hundred Associates, came up the river the city of Ottawa. The first English-speaking person to see the Chaudiere Falls was the English trader, John Wright, who came in 1751. The first settler in the neighbourhood was Nicholas Chaudiere, a clerk from Ireland, who came in 1751. In 1816 and incidentally provided the name of Ottawa's chief thoroughfare of to-day.  
Early first community grew up at Ottawa in 1826, when Col. By, who was sent out from England in 1816 as an engineering and military post at the spot, and in the following year, the trade that developed from the opening-up of the canal for traffic, was named Bytown in his honor.  
Early Ottawa was a community across the river at Hull for some time, ever since Fallomon Wright, an American, had built a house in the United States to settle there. The year before the Rideau Canal was opened, the name of Hull was changed to Bytown, and the name of the Ottawa was changed to Ottawa. When Wright saw the developments that were going to follow upon the opening of the canal, he decided to buy the land, but Sparks was not tricked into an easy bargain.  
Bytown would have been a totally different place from the capital of Canada, and the eternal gratitude of the Canadian people is due to Col. George By, who was originally responsible for having the name changed to Ottawa. Col. By ran a whole-sale house in Hull, and he bought goods from a merchant in L'Orignal. The merchant, adopted the name "Ottawa" for his goods, naming them after the big river that flowed by. By was impressed with the name, and when he returned to Bytown to run the Bank of Ottawa, which also had been named after the river, he decided to buy one and the same name, and he suggested to the men at the head of Canadian Government affairs that the name of the city be changed to Ottawa. He was a good lobbyist and the change went through. And this is why Ottawa is Ottawa and not Bytown.—John Duke in Toronto Sunday World.
