



THE STATE OF THE S It's the It looks like ridges Valleys in Paint That Make it Poor The Valleys are the this streaks. The Hills are the thick streaks DAINT streaks are caused by the brush marks. No matter how much it is brushed, if the paint is cheap the brush marks are bound to show. A cross section of a cheap paint film looks like this. Good paint levels up to a smooth surface. Cheap paint dries with hills and valleys that are alternately strong and weak. Just as a chain is only as strong as its weakest link, so is a film of paint only as good as its thinnest places—the valleys.
