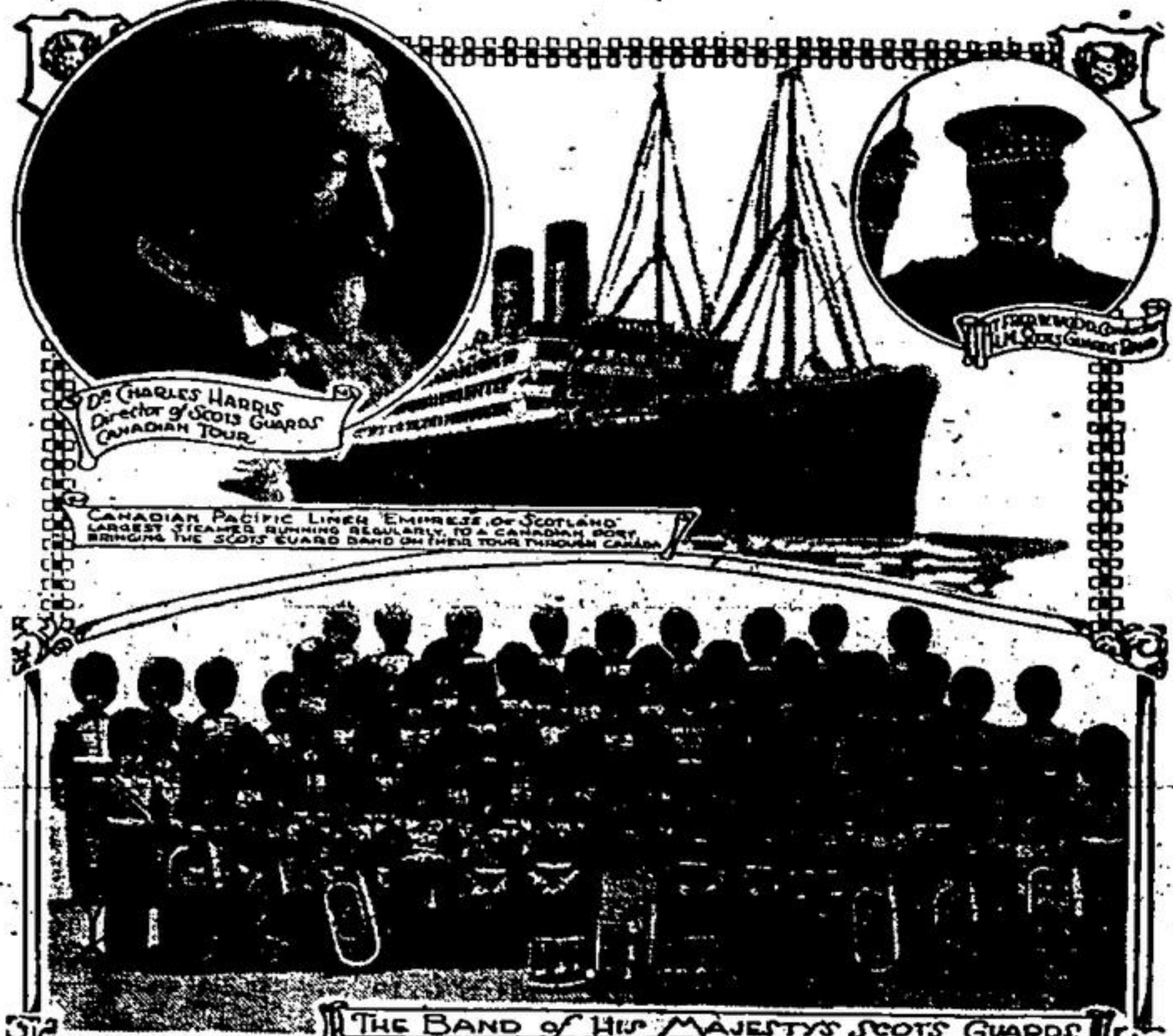
Hunter's Remarkable Trophy

A BAND WITH A HISTORY



That splendid British regiment, the Scots Guards, as they are known to day, looks back to the merry monarch, Charles I., as the chief author of its regional being. In 1640 King Charles authorized the Marquis of Argyll to raise a regiment of 1,500 men to protect the recently placed Scottish colonists in Ireland. It was a fateful beginning. The regiment had its birth in a troublesome job and has fastened in glory on troublesome jobs ever since. Its history is the history of Britain's wars, and it is a long history and a stirring history, for through all the almost 300 years that have since rolled by, it has been only now and then that the Scots Guards have been engaged in peace-keeping. Their colors have flapped in the battle-torn breeze of every country, from Hull to Halifax, in which Britain has had a war, and as Kipling writes, that's a long way if you go in the right direction. If they were in the right direction, they were in the right direction, engaged in civilisation with daymore, bullet and bayonet, and together the Scots Guards has taken a giant part in Britain's big and age-long task of making the world safe for democracy. A most carefully planned and interesting itinerary has been arranged including visits to Montreal, Liverpool, Chester, Stratford-on-Avon, Oxford, London, Paris, Versailles, Fontainebleau, Rheims, Lyons, Marseille, Cannes, Nice, Monaco, Mentone, Genoa, Pisa, Rome, Naples, Sorrento, Capri, Pompeii, Vesuvius, Florence, Venice, Trent, Innsbruck, Munich, the Passion play at Oberammergau, Nuremberg, Mayence, the Rhine, Cologne, Brussels, Louvain and Ostend, returning through London and Liverpool.

This exceptional tour starts from Montreal on Saturday, July 24th, calling at Quebec, by the White Star Line steamship "Canopic" (19,000 tons). A period of approximately two months will be occupied by the tour as by the itinerary the return trip is made from Liverpool by the fine steamship "Regina" (16,500 tons) arriving at Montreal on August 28th. 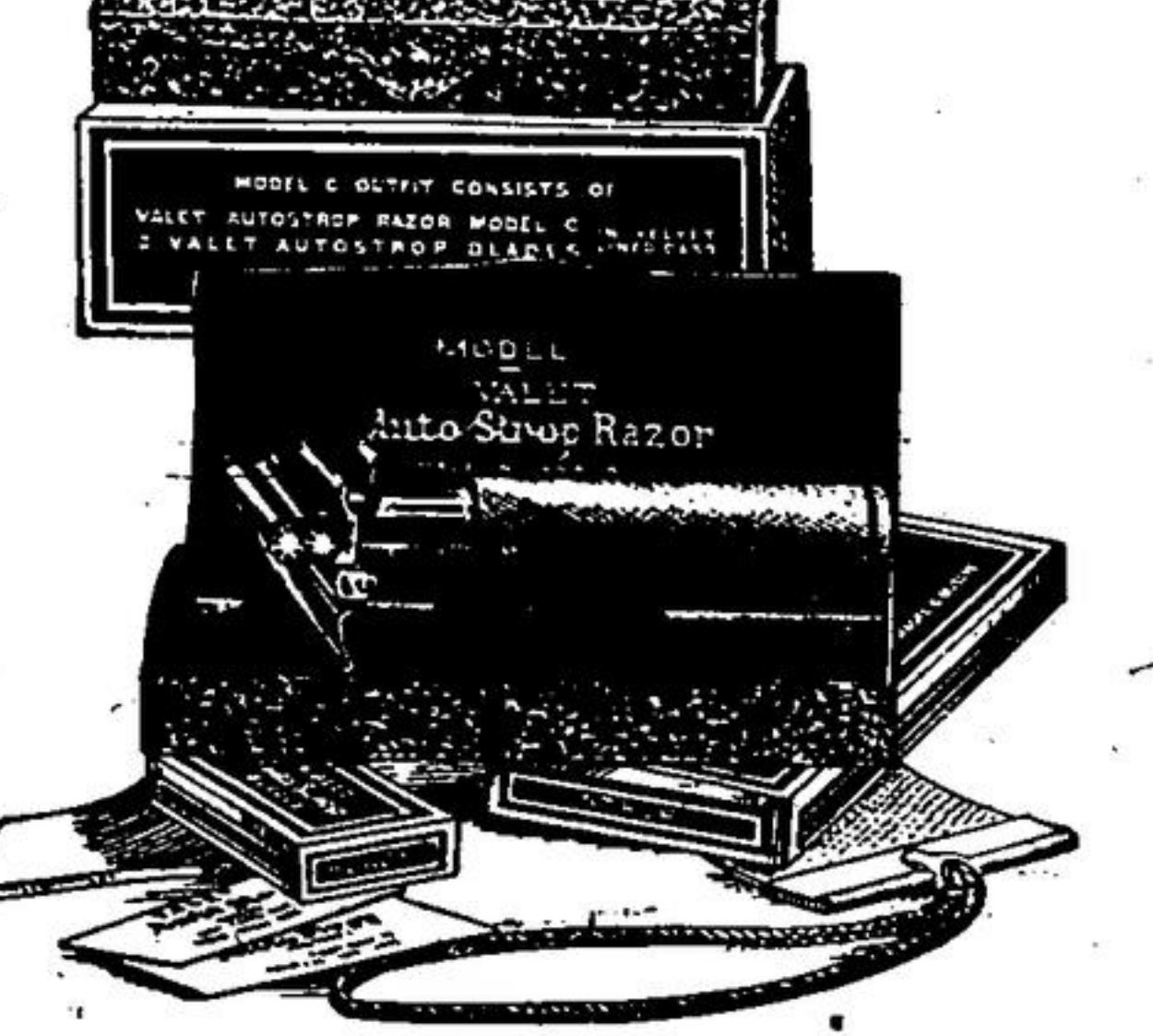
