## Obituary

Mrs. THOMAS BELL

On Wednesday morning last

Mrs. J. A. Thompson received

word from Cleveland of the death

in that city on Tuesday night

of her mother, Mrs. Thomas Bell,

who passed away at the advanced

age of 86 years, following a stroke

which she suffered a week pre-

vious. Mrs. Bell never recovered

the shock she suffered in the

death of her son, James A. Bell

of Georgetown, who died a year ago.

She went to Cleveland at Christ-

mas on a visit to her son, Horbert

W. Bell, barrister of that place.

She was apparently in very good

health, and her death was quite

unexpected. Mrs. Bell is one of

the best known residents of Hal-

ton and Peel. Her father, the

late William Buck, settled on the

9th line, Trafalgar, about a cen-

tury ago. On marriage to Mr.

Bell 63 years ago, she removed to

Stewartville, where she lived

until twenty years ago, when the

family removed to Georgetown.

Her husband died 11 years ago

and there survive one son, H. W.

of Cleveland, and three daughters,

Mrs. John A. Thompson, Geo-

rgtown; Miss E. M. Bell, New York;

and Mrs. W. S. Morphy of Bram-

pton. One brother, Robert Buck,

Cobourg, also survives. Mrs. Bell

was closely associated with the

Baptist church in Georgetown for

more than fifty years and was

formerly one of the most active

workers in that body. The funeral

took place on Friday afternoon

to Greenwood cemetery, Geo-

rgtown, from the residence of her

son-in-law, J. A. Thompson, when

the funeral services were conducted

by Rev. Mr. Moore, pastor of the

Baptist church.

The pallbearers were: Dr. Reid,

Dr. Watson, John McDonald, Wm.

Tyndall, Jas. Buck and Wm.

Thompson.
