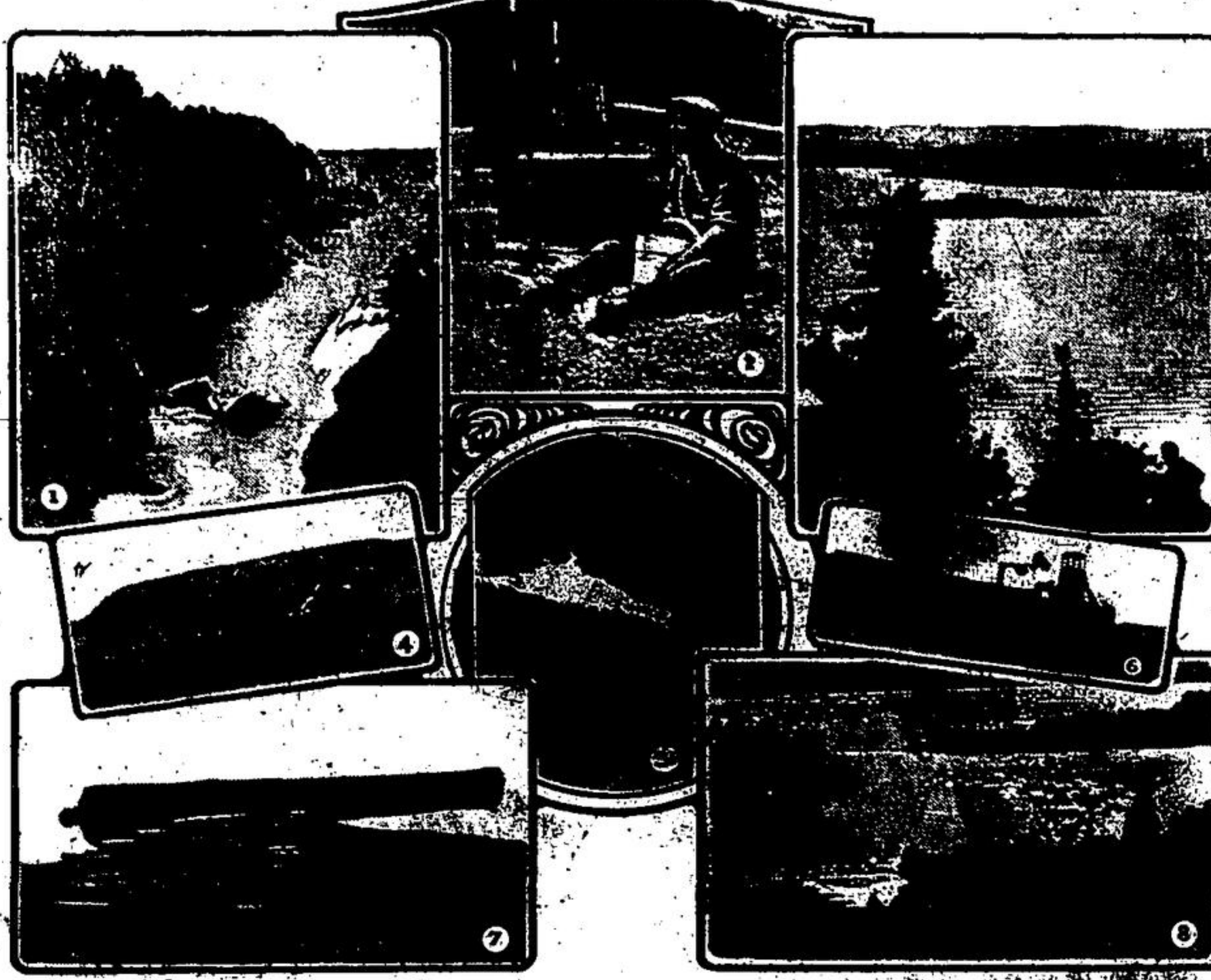

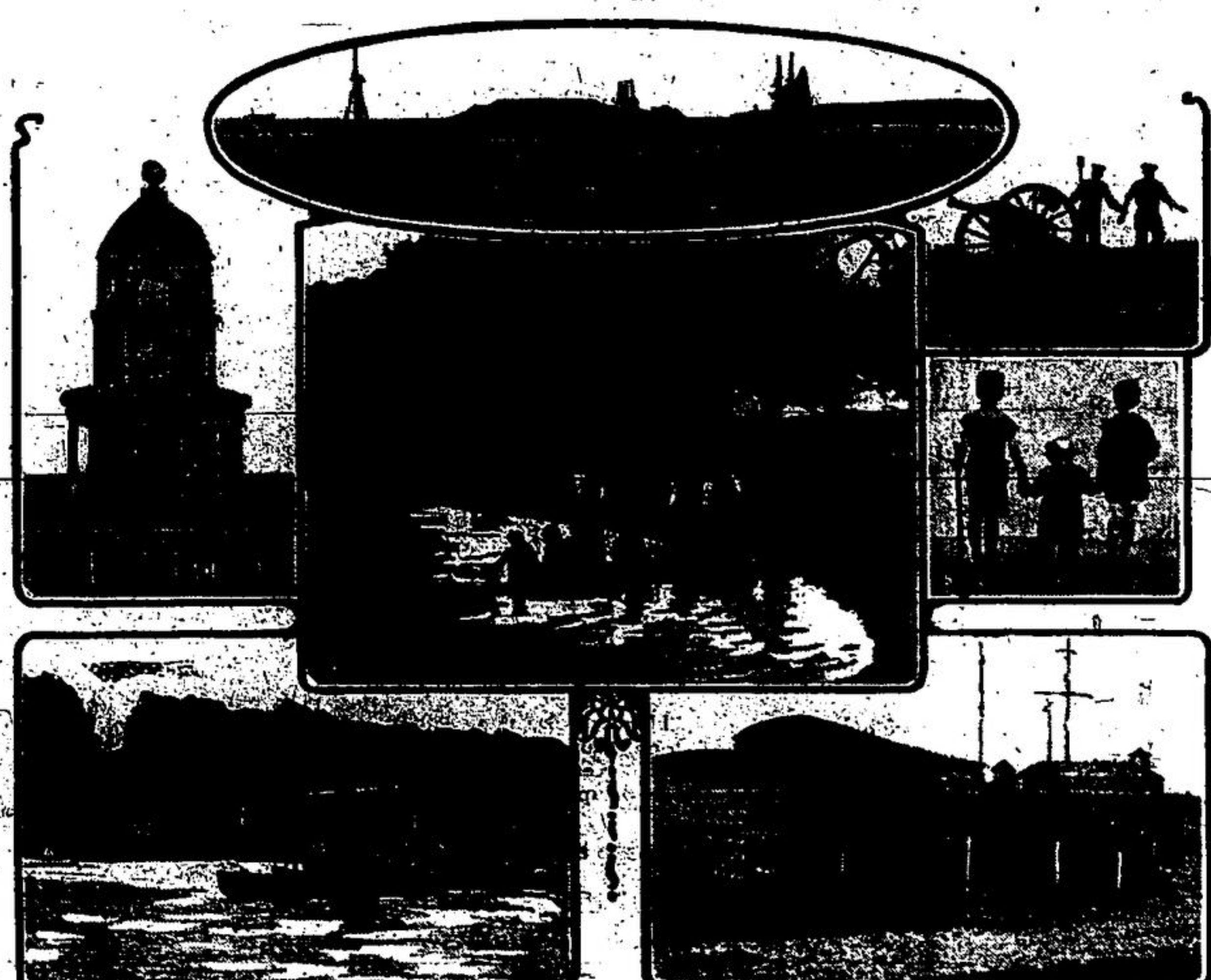
Cape Breton Island - The Front Door of Canada
