In the statement of operating results for the month of August, 1928, issued to-day by the Canadian National Railways, another substantial increase in the net earnings of the System is shown. Gross earnings have increased \$1,568,198 or 7.7% as compared with August, 1927. After deducting operating expenses which amounted to \$19,940,909, a net operating revenue is shown for the month, amounting to \$3,027,886 as compared with net operating revenue of \$1,086,894 for the corresponding month of 1927.
