CANADA AND CONSTITUTION

With Clinging to the Old Form, Says Justice Riddell. "We still cling to the old forms of the constitution," said Justice Riddell, addressing the Electric Club at Toronto recently. After a recent election the Lieutenant Governor did not call upon whom he thought to be the best man to form a government. He may have got the best man, and I do not say he didn't (laugh), but he called upon the leader with the largest following to be Prime Minister.

Author of the "Dunkin' Act." One of the politicians who lived in that noble age which gave us from Union Confederation and made a jumble of colonies into the Canadian country, was the Hon. Christopher Dunkin, once a Minister of Agriculture, remembered by many as the author of the "Dunkin' Act" of total option. His intimate friends recall one phrase which was often upon his lips: "Time and I against the world." His idea of the theory of life was that if you are going straight and rightly, time is on your side and you, or at any rate your cause, is bound to win out ultimately.

Going to Polar Regions. A new expedition to the Polar regions will be undertaken in the course of next summer by Capt. J. E. Bernier, who has already made more than ten voyages in these regions. The Canadian Explorer during the coming winter will go to Europe, where he will supervise the equipment of the "Franklin," which he bought last year for the Federal Government. This ship and the "Arctic" will be used in Capt. Bernier's voyage next summer. Although he is very unwilling to discuss the matter, it is stated that he will attempt to travel through the northwest passage. A scientific expedition will also take part in the voyage.

Wines and beers which are now available on the Quebec-Montreal sections of the Canadian National Railway will also be soon obtainable on the Montreal-Idolift section in the section located in the Province of Quebec. It is reported that several months ago the board of directors of the National Lines decided in favor of the sale of wines and beer on dining cars in the first section mentioned, but the same advantage was not extended to the old international section. In view of the fact that the trains on that division are thorough trains, going through dry provinces, arrangements are said to have been made now by which the liquor will not be placed in bond.
