GROWING SUDAN GRASS

Experimental Results at Ontario Agricultural College.

Average Yields for Five Years For Green Crop and for Hay—How it Compares with Millet and Sorghum—A Good Emergency Crop—About Alfalfa.

(Contributed by Ontario Department of Agriculture) This forage plant, which belongs to the sorghum family, and is one of the finest in leaf and stalk of this group of plants, was introduced into the United States from Africa in 1822.

Sudan Grass has been under test in the experiments at Guelph for the past eight years. During this time it has been grown for its total green fodder yield, for hay, for seed and for pasture.

For the results of this experiment the plots were all sown broadcast. It will be seen that in yield of green fodder and of hay per acre the Sudan Grass was surpassed by five of the crops included in the test.
