PRINCE OF WALES AT JASPER PARK



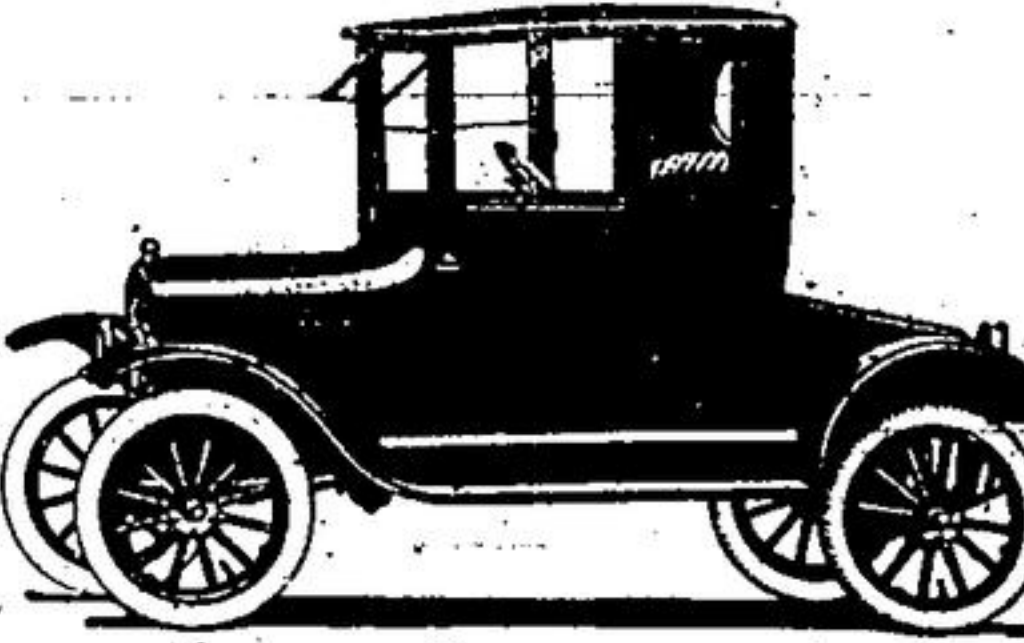
During his trip over the lines of the Canadian National Railways to the Pacific Coast, His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales paid a visit to Jasper National Park, Alberta, the largest national park in the world. The lower left-hand picture shows the Prince chatting with Colonel Maynard Rogers, Superintendent of the Park, beside Jasper's famous totem pole. In the circle on the right is a scene from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police in the district which extends from Edmonton to Hetcher. The Prince of Wales is Honorary Colonel of this famous police force. At the top is a general view of Jasper Park Lodge on the shores of Lac Beauvert, which the Prince visited, and where he was entertained by officers of the Canadian National Railways.
