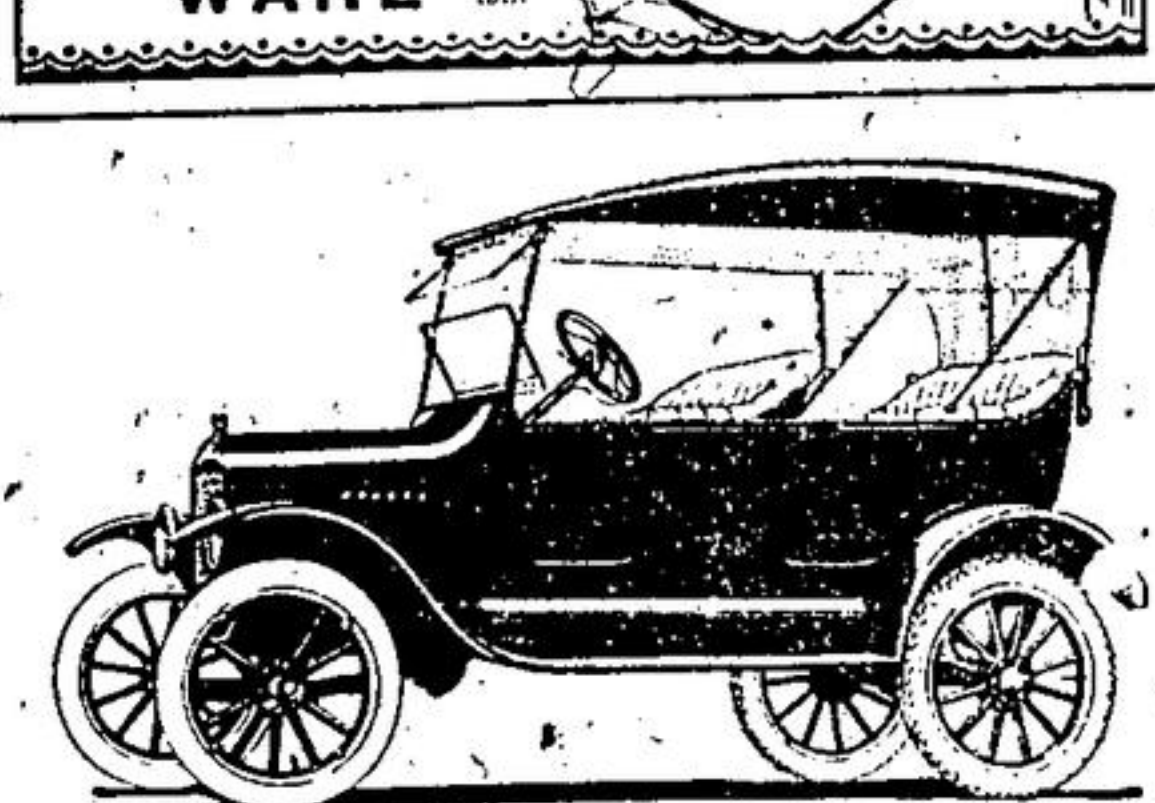
According to instructions issued the first of this month by the Postmaster General, rural mail couriers will in the future have the privilege of observing certain holidays throughout the year.
