Vancouver—A giant merger of timber interests in British Columbia, Washington and Oregon, involving \$400,000,000 of capital, is likely to eventuate in a new company.

Montreal—Despite the lateness of the season new immigration to Canada continues at quite an active rate. Week-end arrivals of the Canadian Pacific Steamships 'Montclair', 'Montcalm' and 'Minnedosa' discharged approximately 1,200 third class passengers to be added to Canada's population.

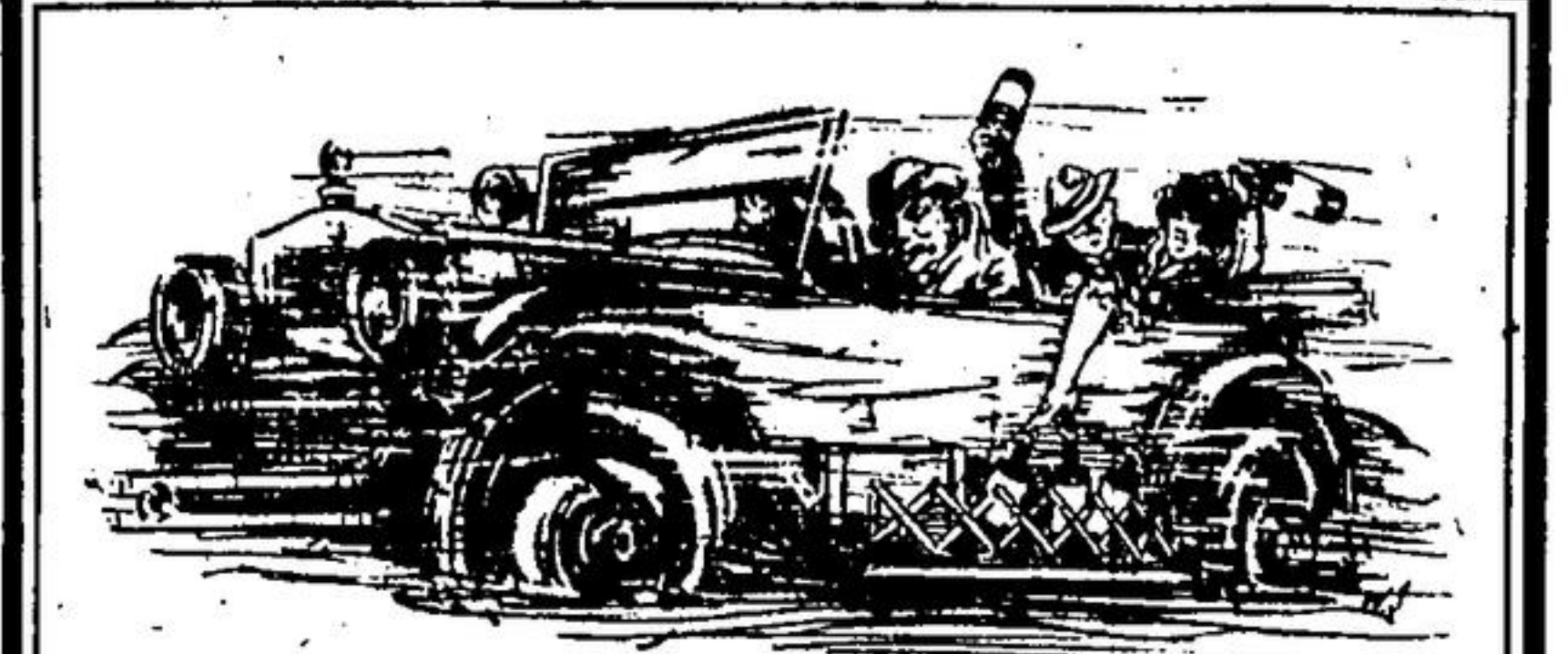
Manitoba's tourist traffic for the 1928 season left over \$7,000,000 in the province, according to the Winnipeg Tourist and Convention Bureau. From the United States a total of 105,710 visitors came into the province of which number 75,012 stayed for a day while 30,698 remained for a longer time.

In order that a more intimate knowledge of the Canadian Pacific Railway shipping terminals in the vicinity of Montreal might be gained, over 150 traffic representatives of the various industrial concerns in the district were the guests of the C.P.R. in a recent tour of the various terminals.

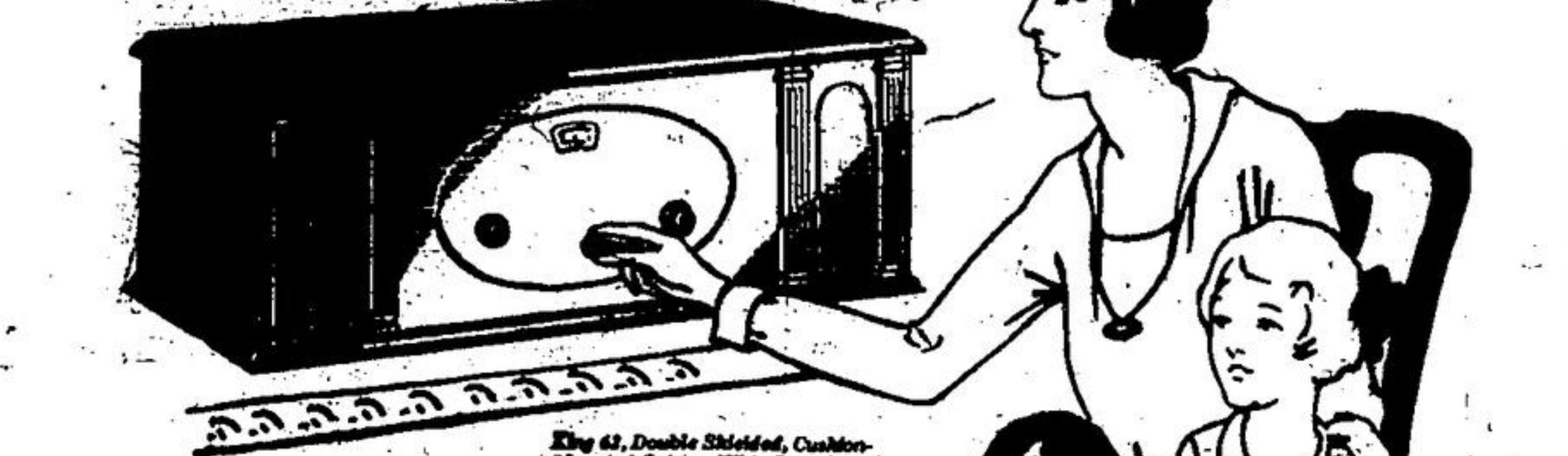
