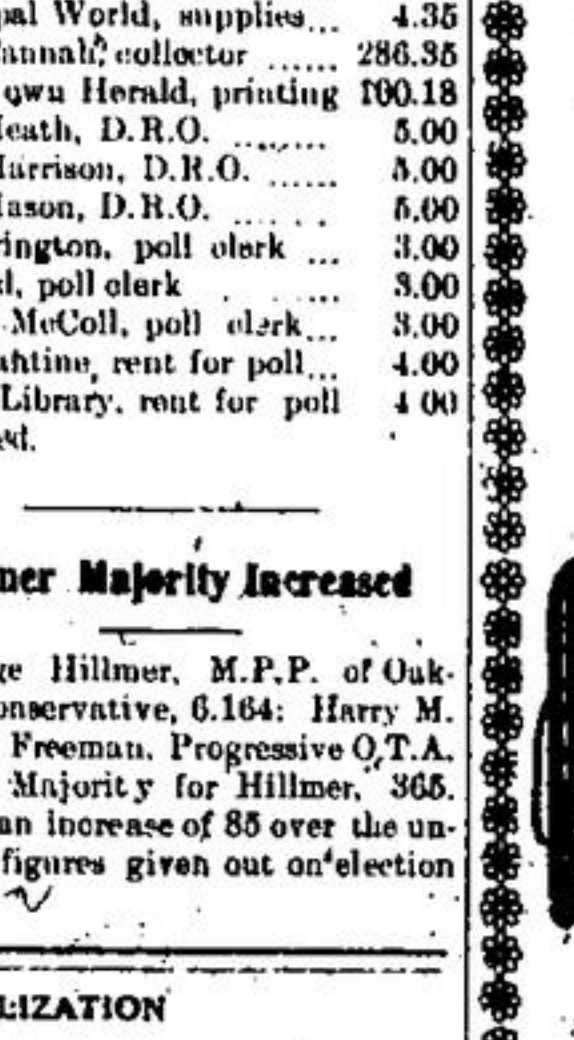

Oakville May Secede From Halton County

Possibility of secession of the town of Oakville from the County of Halton was freely discussed, apparently in a favorable spirit, at the meeting of the council last Monday night in Oakville, when the report of the decision of Judge Elliot on the re-assessment equalization was presented.

Other towns, notably Burlington, which is leading in this matter are considering like steps. Widespread alarm at the increased burdens to be placed upon them has led to concerted action with reference to the appeal. The equalization of the townships has been lowered.

Last year, Oakville's assessment for county purposes was \$1,760,000, raised this year to \$3,800,000. The total county assessment was raised from \$9,000,000 to \$22,000,000, so that Oakville is paying this year 11.9 per cent of the county expenditure, as compared with 8.5 per cent last year. This means that \$21,000, approximately, will have to be raised by the town, as compared with \$14,500 last year.
