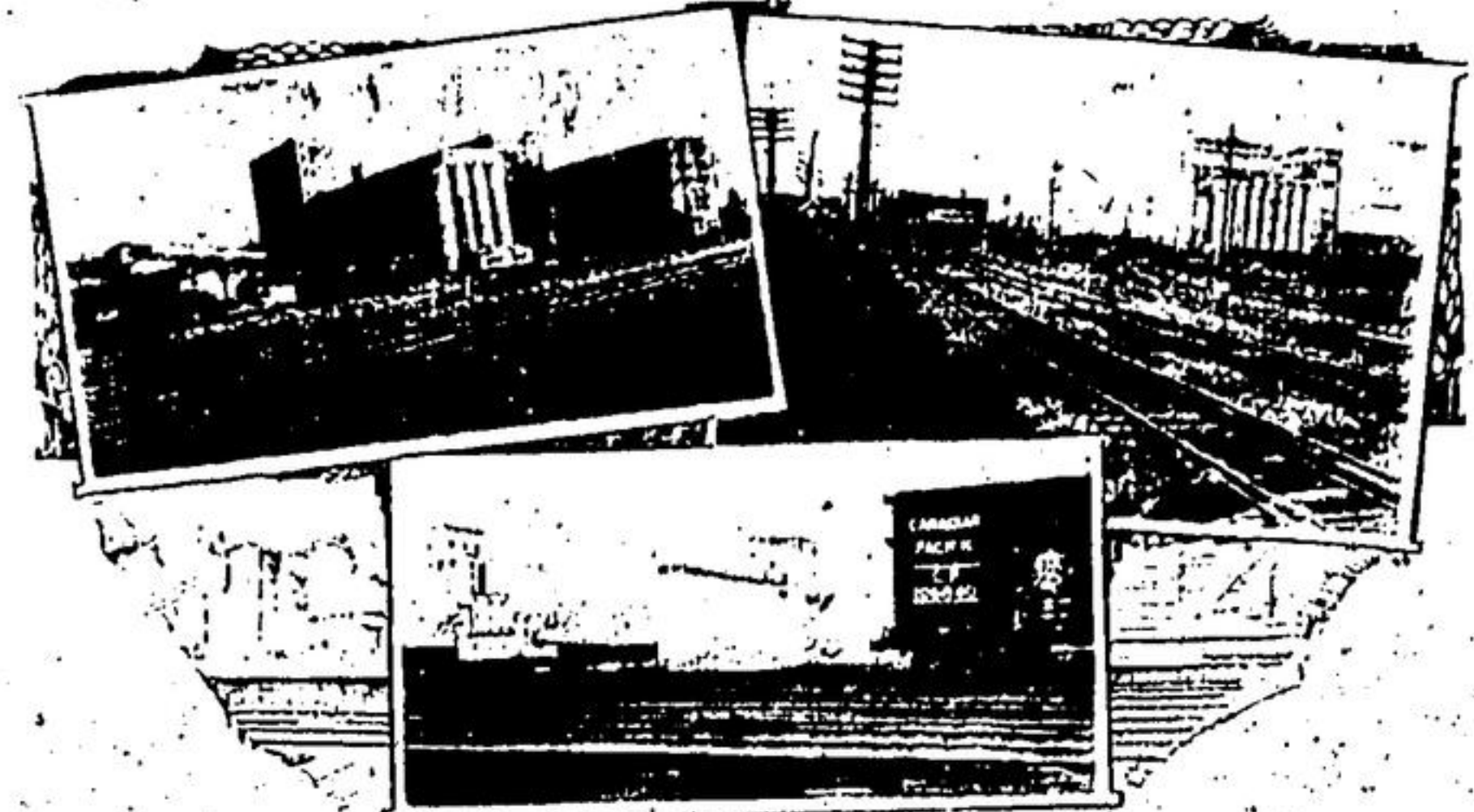

Citizens are Requested to Comply with the Public Health Act. 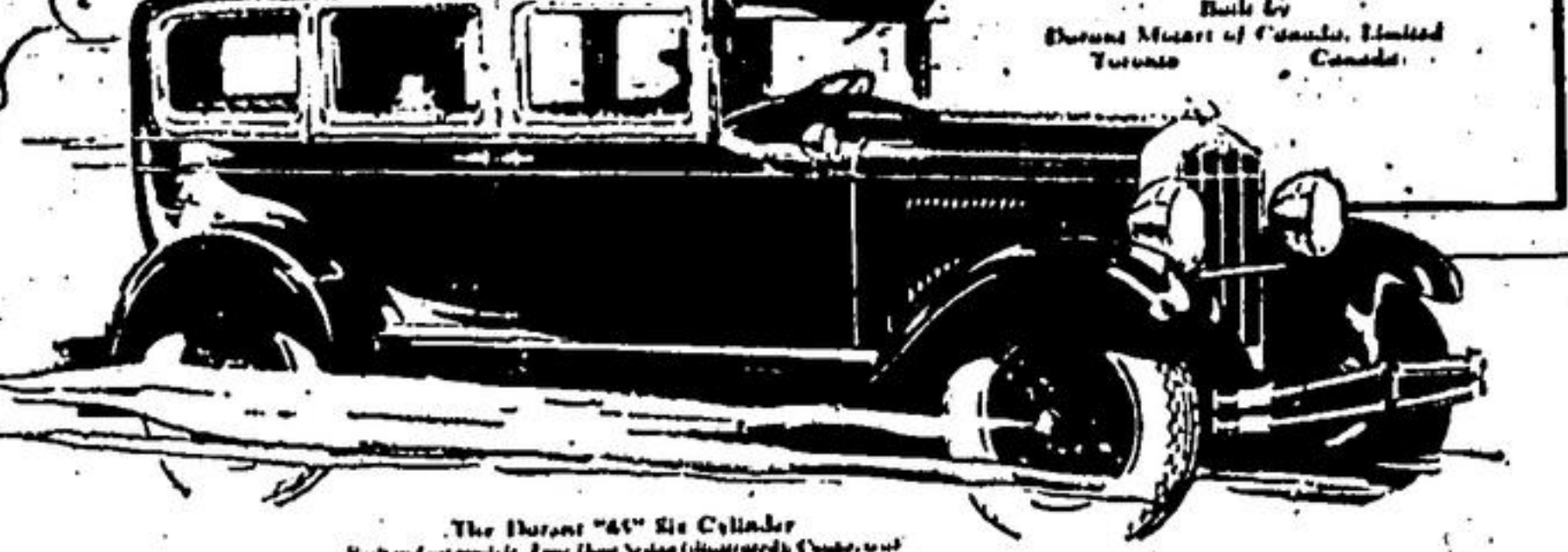

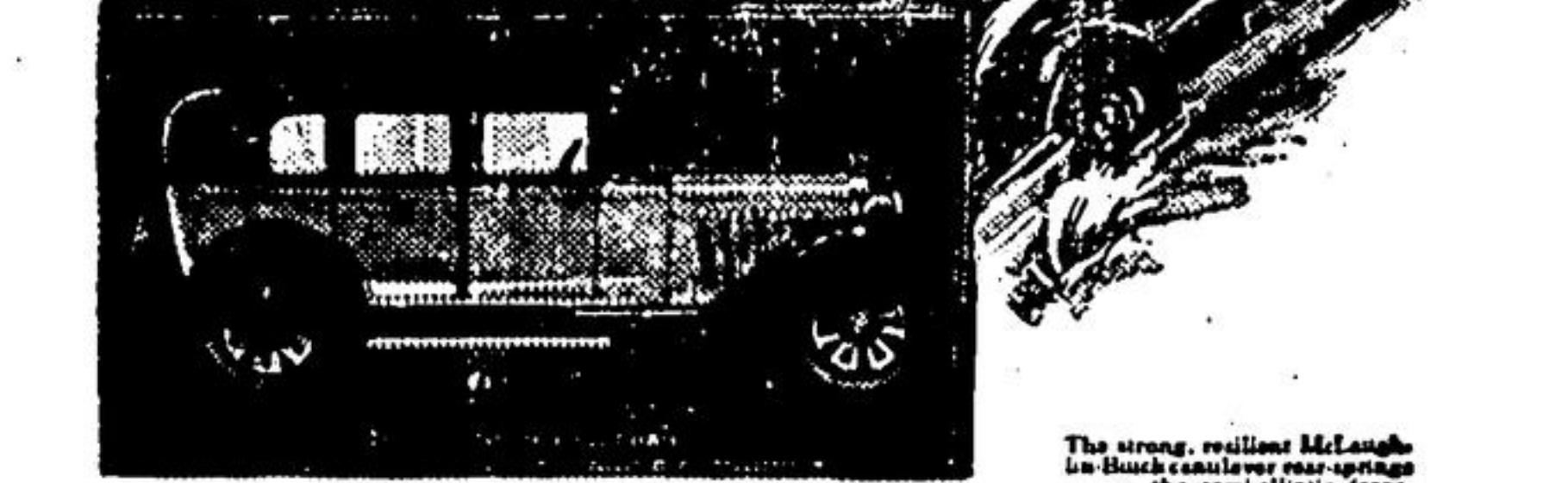
