Barn Burned

About 3 o'clock last Wednesday morning fire of unknown origin completely destroyed Charles Hill's fine barn at Fern. The loss includes 60 prize chickens, a number of which were to have been exhibited at the Canadian National Exhibition, part of the season's crop, implements, etc., and a dog. The barn was equipped with all modern conveniences, including electric light. The Milton Fire Brigade responded to the call for assistance, and Mr. Hill's prize rooster mare and cattle, which are to be exhibited at the C.N.E., some implements, harness, buggy and cutter were saved. The loss is estimated at about \$5,000, partly covered by insurance.
