TRANSCONTINENTAL BROADCAST WILL ESTABLISH NEW RECORD

Sir Henry Thornton, Chairman and President of the Canadian National Railways, will deliver the chief address in a transcontinental network of radio broadcasts for the night of December 27th next. To effect this the Canadian National Railway will be required to connect the longest East to West tie-in ever prepared on this continent, requiring over 12,000 miles of telephone and telephone wires to hook up the fourteen broadcasting stations in the five time zones of the Dominion, from tide-water to tide-water, linking Halifax with Vancouver.

The "key" station on this occasion will be CNRM, at Montreal, and from the Metropolitan Sir Henry will speak to the hundred thousand employees of the National System. One other address will be made, that by W. D. Todd, Vice-President, who directs the radio activities of the company. Mr. Todd will speak in French.

A programme of musical and vocal offerings by a selected group of artists has been arranged for this special occasion.

During a period of five years this annual tie-in-broadcast has been increasing in magnitude. In 1924 Ottawa and Montreal were hooked up, a distance of approximately 120 miles. Later Toronto was added. Then Winnipeg and Quebec and the hookup now arranged by the radio engineers of the National System parallels 3700 miles of railway and has been made possible by the extension of the efficient carrier current system of the Canadian National Telegraphs.

Approximately 200 picked men will be required during the tie-in to superintend the "cable" stations, and also for monitoring purposes at broadcasting stations.

The following cities will be included:

In the network: Atlantic Standard Time Zone, Halifax, N.B.; Saint John, Fredericton and Moncton, N.B.; Eastern Standard Time Zone, Quebec and Montreal, Que.; Ottawa, Toronto and London, Ont.; Central Standard Time Zone, Saskatoon, Sask., and Edmonton, Alta.; Pacific Standard Time Zone, Vancouver, B.C.

THE OPEN BED-ROOM WINDOW

One of the really striking changes in personal habits which has occurred within recent years is the habit of opening the bed-room window at night.

It is not so many years ago since the windows were closed, with the coming of cold weather. Indeed, many persons stuffed the few cracks around the windows to make sure that no air came in from outside. That was the time when a sick person was protected from fresh air being had in not too plentiful if it would cause his death.

We may forget that tuberculosis, the first disease which was fought by education. Other diseases had been fought by police measures, by compulsion. People were forced to leave their homes and work-places, were obliged to attend sanitary conventions; if they suffered from a runny nose or a cough, they were isolated whether they wished to or not.

The fight against tuberculosis has not been along this line. In place of force, persuasion, by means of education, was used. The educational work has not been limited to those suffering from tuberculosis, but has extended to all. From the start, the value of fresh air was stressed and we were advised to open our bedroom windows in order to benefit by and enjoy hours of sleep in the fresh air, thus lessening the chances of the occurrence of tuberculosis.

It is true that fresh air, day and night, is good. We know that the old idea of fresh air being had is not true. At night, we miss the sunshine; that is the only difference. Those who sleep with bed-rooms closed, they are better, they feel better and they are better.

The window is, of course, opened with consideration for the temperature and the wind. If a fraction of an inch on a cold, windy night allows a slight current of cool air to pass through the room, that is sufficient. Fresh air is one of the valuable things that may be had simply for the effort of taking it.
