#### TUBERCULOSIS IN CHILDREN

At the last annual meeting of the Canadian Public Health Association, Dr. H. M. Peck reported the results of a research which is of public interest. This research was concerned with the important subject of the spread of bovine tuberculosis, that is, the type of tuberculosis from which cattle suffer and which also attacks children.

From the report, the following statements are quoted:—"The incidence of bovine infection in man, therefore, depends upon the amount of tuberculosis in cattle from which the milk is obtained, and the amount of raw milk consumed by children." "In Canada, about five per cent. of the cattle test react to tuberculin." "The younger the individual, the greater is the probability of the infection through the milk consumed, and the more likely is the case to be due to the bovine type."

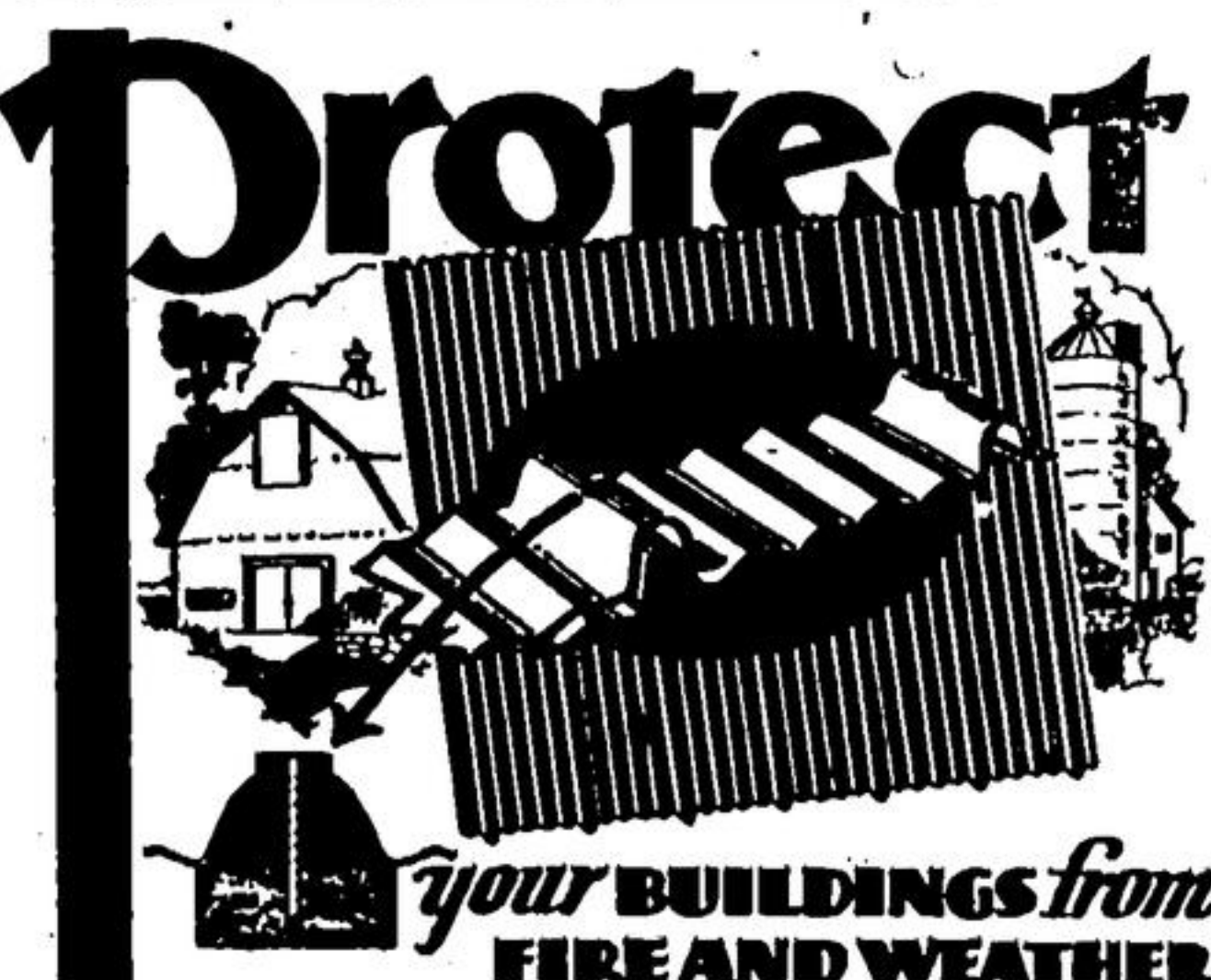
