ANNUAL REPORT OF MEDICAL HEALTH OFFICER

Following is the report of the Medical Health Officer of Georgetown for the year 1929.

Georgetown, January 15, 1929. To the Chairman and Members of the Local Board of Health, Georgetown, Ontario.

Gentlemen:— I beg to submit herewith my annual report upon the sanitary condition of the municipality for the year ending Dec. 31st, 1929.

Vital Statistics: Births 27; Deaths 19.

Communicable Diseases: Cerebro spinal meningitis 0; Chicken pox 7; Scarlet fever 14; Diphtheria 2; Whooping cough 9; Measles 3; Mumps 3.

Quarantine and isolation has been strictly enforced, but it is regretted that a considerable number of residents do not co-operate, and make it difficult to control the spread of disease.

Water Supply: None. Streams and reservoirs. Treatment—None. Number of samples sent to laboratories, 11. Samples particularly in the spring, occasionally show contamination with intestinal organisms and may at some time be a real menace to the health of the town.

Milk Supply: Number of distributors, raw milk, 6; pasteurized milk, 2. Milk Inspector Dr. B. Learmonth. Number of samples sent to laboratory, 96. Number of visits to premises of producers, 24.

Number of times visited, 6. Sanitary conveniences—condemned unattended and unhealthy; lighting of rooms—good; defective blackboards—none; Heating—fair; Ventilation—fair; Drinking water facilities—1 common cup destroyed, otherwise satisfactory.

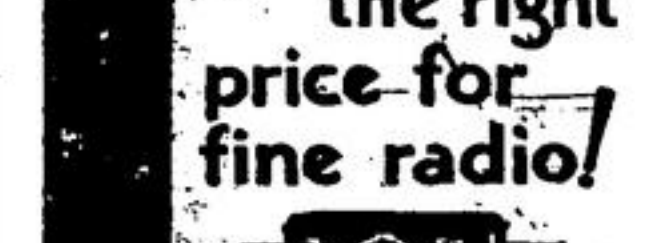
