### Legislature Prorogued

First session of Ontario's 18th legislature was prorogued on Thursday by Hon. W. D. Ross, Lieutenant-Governor, accompanied by the ancient customs of British Parliaments. The Lieutenant-Governor after reviewing the military guards, was escorted into the Legislative chamber by Hon. G. Howard Ferguson, Prime Minister, who then, without shade of doubt, I knew 'That glorious Resurrection true.

The spring is coming somewhat later than usual," said his honor, "but much work was done last fall and the stock have wintered favourably. The improvement in the methods of production and marketing continues to be the most valuable assistance that can be given to agriculture. In regard to Hydro, His Honor observed that legislation passed at the session just concluded would open up enlarged spheres of usefulness for this great public undertaking. The measures you have adopted will help to extend the advantages of electrical services in the rural districts," said Hon. Mr. Ross. "Plans have been approved which will serve to make power more generally available for the mining industry. These changes together with the increased normal demand for power have made it necessary to secure additional sources for the production of electrical energy."

Amendments made to the school laws provide a progressive system of Primary School Inspection, he continued, as well as increasing facilities for Secondary education. This legislation combined with the generous aid you have given to all branches of education will be confidently hoped tend to stimulate the efforts of teachers and trustees in this most important public service.

Commenting on the financial responsibility law for automobile drivers, his Honor said: "This law will assist in the control and regulation of motor transportation. Increased financial help has been provided for rural roads, while the proposal that the provincial roads be officially designated 'The King's Highway' has met with general approval and has been embodied in the law of the province."

In connection with the Security Funds Prevention Act, and the proposed amendment to the Liquor Control Act, his Honor observed that the principles approved at the Conference of Attorneys-General have been embodied in the laws of the province. As to the new five year seasonal term, his Honor said this important change, meeting with general public approval will make the law on this subject almost uniform throughout the Dominion.

Touching on the Liquor Control situation, his Honor said the report of the Liquor Control Commission gives valuable information as to the operations of the Act. The sale of native wines has been brought within the scope of the permit system and the law amended with the view to making it more effective in the interest of sobriety.

Additional safeguards for workers engaged in mining operations have been provided for, in conformity with the recommendations made by the investigating commission. It is to be hoped, observed Hon. Mr. Ross, that this enlightened legislation will receive the co-operation of all concerned and will serve to ameliorate conditions which have been a menace in the past.

An increased bonus on iron ore is offering additional encouragement to an industry basic in its nature making a step forward which is likely to have far-reaching consequences for the prosperity of the province.

Pointing toward Northern Ontario, his Honor drew attention to a further \$10,000,000 appropriated for the development of that section of the province, providing for the continuance of an undertaking of the utmost importance. "Your faith in the future of the northland will afford opportunities for many prosperous communities both now and in the generations to come," said His Honor.

Satisfactory progress is being made with the extension of the provincial railway towards James' Bay, while there is every assurance that the road will reach the newly discovered coal region early in the coming summer. Many suggestions are contained in the report of the special committee appointed to enquire into the game fish situation in Ontario. These suggestions will receive full consideration during the recess.

Legislation has also been enacted to improve the quality of dairy production and the prevention of forest fires, and for the better prevention of vexatious legal proceedings.

Concluding His Honor said: "I think you for the enactment of much beneficial legislation, and I trust that under the blessing and protection of Almighty God, your labours will advance the welfare and happiness of our people."

During the session, the Legislature held thirty-nine sittings, including several night sessions. Some 100 bills passed the House.

Hopes to Eliminate Weeds. Should dreams of Dr. G. I. Christie, President of the O.A.C., be realized, now thistle will disappear from Ontario farms and the O. A. C. will achieve one of the greatest accomplishments in its history. A new research program is to be launched by the college authorities aiming at the elimination of noxious weeds in general, and now thistle in particular.

To Employ 15,000 Census-Takers. Preparations are being made for taking another decennial census in Canada. Credit for taking the modern and scientific census is claimed by Canada. This was taken of the Colony of New France in Canada in 1666, says "Canada Week by Week." It was a systematic "nominal enumeration" of the "taken" or "what was known as the de jure principle, of a fixed date, showing age, sex, occupation and conjugal and family condition. That census recorded 3215 persons. The census to be taken in Canada next year will give employment to 15,000 persons, or about five times as many as the entire population of Canada when the first census was taken.
