WRIGLEY'S INAUGURATE PENSION FOR EMPLOYEES

Company Contributors Nearly \$100,000 to Start Pension Plan

TO PROLONG LIFE OF CUT FLOWERS

In keeping flowers beautiful, no information is more appreciable than the informative advice on how to keep cut flowers fresh. With this end in view, the Lethbridge Experimental Station of the Dominion Department of Agriculture has assembled the most salient facts of the art, both from their own horticulturists and from other authorities. Most flower growers are expert in this line of marketing, but the dew will still be on them, so it is to be remembered that dahlia must be cut in full bloom; iris, poppies and pink in half bloom, and peacock when they show a good colour.

The method of cutting is also important. Blighting cuts with sharp instruments are to be avoided, as such cuts are apt to stop the flow of sap, and thus the free flow of water through the stalks is impeded.

One good alternative is to make a shallow cut, and then dip the flower in water until the stem is moistened.

In order to assist employees who have been with the Company for many years before the start of the plan, Wrigley's have made a cash contribution of \$100,000 to the fund of almost \$100,000 to cover these years of service.
