There were 4,805 accidents reported to the Workmen's Compensation Board during April, as compared with 4,338 during March, and 4,350 during April a year ago.

The benefits awarded during April amounted to \$508,202.27, of which \$342,633.38 was for compensation and \$165,568.89 for medical aid.

OPPOSE WANTON ABUSE OF THE WILD FLOWERS

The recent official adoption of the wild-flower emblem of Ontario may also prove its death-knell, unless the public restrains its hands from indiscriminate picking of the flower. Consequently the Ontario Horticultural Association has renewed its efforts to arouse public sentiment towards the protection of the trillium and of all wild flowers. From early spring until the fall, the fields, woods and glens of Canada provide a succession of flowers, more varied and quite as beautiful as any to be found in the best gardens. Unfortunately, many persons, particularly of the larger centres of population, regard this abundance as free gift to be ravished at will. It is against this unrestrained gathering of wild flowers that the Association is taking a firm stand.

The reckless picking of wild flowers has already caused the disappearance of some of the finest plants in the woods through the damage caused by removing with the blooms all the foliage which is needed to mature the roots. The Ontario Horticultural Association, in making a public appeal against the lavish gathering of wild flowers, urges upon school teachers and pupils the necessity for protecting the white trillium. It is one of the wild plants which should never be gathered freely, if at all, because the blooms cannot be picked without removing all the foliage and on this foliage depends the maturing of the bulbous root for the following season's crop. Some species of wild flowers, such as violets, hepaticas, and others with flower stems rising directly from the roots, may be freely picked so long as the plant body is not disturbed. Other wild flowers, however, such as the white trillium, are best left undisturbed in their native beauty.

The picking of wild flowers should be done only in a sane and thoughtful manner with due regard for the future. Sufficient flowers should always be left to form seeds and it goes without saying that no wild plant should ever be pulled up by the roots. What is needed for the protection of wild flowers, states J. B. Spencer, Past President of the Ontario Horticultural Association, is the developing of an attitude towards the native flora similar to that which has come to possess the youth of Canada towards wild life. Instead of rushing for a gun or a catapult when an unusual bird or animal is sighted, the normal lad now takes his pleasure in erecting bird houses and feeding stations, and in other ways making friends with the feathered or furry visitors which come and go to remain throughout the year to add so much to the joys of life. With organized effort this same sentiment can be developed towards the flowers of the fields and the woods throughout the whole Dominion.

TESTED RECIPES

Variety in Egg Dishes

Science has discovered the existence of several vitamins in food, each vitamin being essential for a certain phase of growth or for the prevention of a particular type of disease. No one item of food possesses all the vitamins in the quantities required by the human system, but no other single food has a wider vitamin content than eggs. Eggs contain vitamins A, B₁, B₂, and D. Vitamins A and D essential to growth, also to the prevention of certain eye troubles, and to the proper development of bones and teeth are found abundantly in eggs, while vitamin B₁, the vitamin of yeast, which prevents nervous breakdown, loss of weight, and anaemia is also present in moderate quantities.

Egg Croquettes

6 eggs
3 tablespoons butter
1 slice of onion
1/2 cup flour
1 cup white stock
Yolk of 3 eggs
Salt
Crisped cheese
Pepper

Poach eggs and dry on towel. Cook butter with onion three minutes. Add flour and gradually the stock. Cook one minute and cool. Cover eggs with mixture, roll in bread crumbs, fry in deep fat, and drain on brown paper. The croquettes may be served with a thin sauce, using equal parts of white stock and cream, and seasoning with grated cheese, salt, and pepper.

Scrambled Eggs with Tomato Sauce

6 eggs
1 1/2 cups tomatoes
2 tablespoons sugar
4 tablespoons butter
1 slice onion
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon pepper

Simmer tomatoes and sugar five minutes. Fry butter and onion three minutes. Remove onion and add tomatoes, seasoning and eggs slightly beaten. Cook as for scrambled eggs. Serve with whole-wheat or brown bread.

Scrambled Eggs with Peas

Mix six eggs with half cup of milk. Season with salt and pepper; then add one-half cup of peas. Scramble slowly in buttered pan. Corn, chopped meat, parsley, or green peppers may be used instead of peas. Also instead of scrambling, this entree may be made in omelet form.

A recent research report on the development of home-building during the past 20 years shows that there is scarcely any industry starting two decades ago that has shown greater progress in design, durability, efficiency and structure methods. The waste space of the old-fashioned parlor has been used as an all-use living room; things scarcely in the experimental stage to recent industry in home-keeping 20 years ago are commonplace today—the "miracle" sofa.

Space for relaxation, such as recreation rooms in the basement, and sleeping porches to promote health and comfort, are considered in every well-designed house. Windows are carefully weather-stripped; walls and ceilings are washable and insulated to give coolness in summer and warmth in winter. Mechanical equipment in homes of today would have astounded urban-dwellers of a quarter-century ago.

The garage took its place at the rear and gradually it has moved up and attached itself to the house, sometimes at the side, sometimes underneath.

The dingy, damp, and stuffy basement, which was the catch all storage dump for the entire household, has become one of the most serviceable parts of the house. The waterproof basement is well-lighted, clean and airy. Workshops for the child, recreation rooms, playrooms or ping-pong and carol rooms, have become as desirable in the basement as in any other part of the house.

With all this advancement, the individuality or personality of the house has not been sacrificed, the report points out. In the commercial and apartment field and in scientific management, remodeling and modernizing of structures and equipment, there live a field in which builders, equipment manufacturers and restorers are making great strides.
